I'm writing about the "Anti-Communist Action" group that has announced that they're going to demonstrate in Charlotte December 28th.


I'm deeply concerned about the safety of residents, counter-protesters and police. The group has instructed members to bring torches, guns and armor, indicating that it has no intention of a peaceful demonstration. At the very least it intends to intimidate and incite.

Can you tell me a little bit about what Charlotte will do to mitigate those risks, if the group does receive a permit to demonstrate?

From 2012 to 2016 Charlotte had an "Extraordinary Events Ordinance," which prohibited a wide number of items, many of which were not a serious threat to others. It was repealed because it was ineffective. While it was active it was controversial because of the possible violation of people's rights.

But is there no middle ground? Can't a reasonable solution be that people can bring in bottles, but not semi-automatic weapons? If it was constitutional for four years to prohibit rocks from 4th of July celebrations, surely it's also constitutional to prohibit assault weapons from Nazi rallies?

I'm interested to know your thoughts on this and what we will do to keep our city safe.
