



On 21 March 2018, anti-racists and white supremacists will hold competing demonstrations at the University of Tennessee (UT) in Knoxville, Tennessee.

Traditionalist Worker Party (TWP) indicated it will gather to oppose a "militant Marxist group" and their "takeover of UT." An organizer of the TWP demonstration declared: "White nationalists are being fired across the country...many losing their homes. The best thing WNs, who can't do street activism, can do is donate some money to our 'club house' fund, so we can have living arrangements established for our folk in need."
