NARRATIVE

At 2351 hours on 07/08/2016, I, Sqd. 409, Officer J. Sauer was in the area of Grand Ave. and Chatsworth when I heard information aired there were 5 suspicious males leaving the area of the protest at the Governor's Mansion, possibly armed.

With Officers J. Griffin and R. McAlpine, we located the males on the northeast corner of Grand and Chatsworth. We watched the males until other squads arrived in the area. Once other squads arrived, B80 (Cmdr. Frazer) requested the males be Id'd and their permits to carry verified.

With the other squads we approached the males and Id'd each of them as the following:

I ran all parties on the Data Channel. All parties came back clear. DAVIES and MATTILA's permits to carry came back valid. Data attempted to contact St. Croix County in Wisconsin, to verify PIETERS' permitted but was unable to. The permit appeared to be valid and did not expire until 2017.

Per Sgt. Moore (Sqd. 303) and Cmdr. Frazer we released the males at the scene.

At the time of the stop we were unaware Minnesota and Wisconsin did not share reciprocity to carry in each other state.

I (SQD. #107, C. Sims) received information from several of the protesters that 5 white males were seen at the

protest located on Summit Ave. and Chatsworth St. with guns in their waste bands. I received suspect clothing descriptions and aired it to surrounding detail squads. Spdd Officers located the males at the intersection of Chatsworth St. and Grand Ave. Upon my arrival on scene, I noticed that one of the males who was identified as Aaron Louis Davies, DOB: [REDACTED] had a 45 caliber handgun holstered on his right hip. He was handcuffed prior to my arrival on scene but the gun was still holstered on his hip. For Officers safety, I removed the gun from Davies hip and I removed the magazine and the bullet that was chambered in the gun to render the gun safe. I was later instructed to return the weapon to Davies by Commander Fraizer. I returned the gun to Davies unloaded and I gave Davies the ammunition to the gun separated from the gun. The group of W/M's were possibly in possession of handguns and appeared not to belong to the protest. The males left the protest and walked SB toward Grand and Chatsworth.

We approached the males along with several other squads. I spoke to a male later ID as Nathaniel Adam Pieters. Pieters informed me that he had a handgun on his right hip and had his conceal to carry permit ID in his wallet. Pieters said his permit ID was from Wisconsin. I told Pieters to place his hands behind his head and for my safety and all the officers on scene safety, placed Pieters in handcuffs.

I located a handgun on Pieters' right hip, a magazine in his front pants pocket and another magazine attached to his belt. I removed the handgun from Pieters' hip.

Officer Sauer ran Pieters' Wisconsin ID and permit to carry ID. Pieters came back clear.

I removed Pieters' handcuffs and released his handgun back to him.

NARRATIVE

Squad 417 (McAlpine) of C/N FORCE, while working a detail with W/S FORCE Officers (Griffin / Sauer), assisted squads in the area of Grand and Chatsworth. B80 (Cmdr. Frazier), aired information about 5 suspicious white males in the area of the protest acting strange and one was possibly armed.

We later located the suspects in the area of Grand / Chatsworth on the North/West corner. I made contact, and later performed a pat down search on (Davies, Aaron Louis). Davies stated he was armed and had a permit to carry.

While performing a pat down for Officer safety, I spoke with Davies and informed him that I was going to place him in handcuffs while I verified his permit. I communicated all of my actions with Davies and he was cooperative. Sgt. Sims assisted in securing Davies pistol from his waistband. Davies also had two loaded magazines in his left front pocket. I then had Davies have a seat on the curb while W/S FORCE Officers verified the permit and ran name / gun checks.

Once the gun was secured and other squads had arrived to assist, I later un-cuffed Davies. I also assisted in un-cuffing (Pieters, Nathaniel Adam), and again had both parties sit on the curb while we finished verifying the checks.

Davies stated he was a Military Vet, and that he lived in Mankato. Davies stated he drove up from Mankato separately and his group of friends met him in the area. Davies explained that he wanted to see what the

protests were about and to show support for all causes. Davies stated a group from the protest clearly did not want them there and had followed them out of the area.

We later returned the firearms to Davies and he was released.

When we arrived, squads had located and detained the males on the northeast corner of the intersection. At least two of the males were carrying handguns. We stood by while the males were identified and their permits to carry were verified. The males complied with all instructions given by officers.

Once identified, it was determined by primary squads no laws had been broken. The males were released at the scene.

NARRATIVE

On 07-08-2016 Sgt T. Moore and Sgt R. Murphy were on scene of a group of males at the corner of Chatsworth and Grand. The group had been observed within the protest at the Governor's residence and police were informed that at least one of the males was armed.

We stopped the males with the assistance of numerous other squads and all parties were identified (see Officer Sauer's report). At the conclusion of the contact the males were all released including Nathaniel Adam Pieters, who was in possession of a handgun with a Wisconsin driver's license and a Wisconsin permit to carry. After they were released we researched the validity of the Wisconsin permit to carry and we determined the permit was not valid in Minnesota due to no reciprocity between Wisconsin and Minnesota.

I (Sgt T. Moore) then contacted a male who identified himself as "Bertrand" at [redacted]. Bertrand told me he was the leader of the Black Man's Stand Up Movement and he was contacted by a person at the protest at the Governor's residence. Bertrand was told that there was a group of 5-7 white males who were walking through the protest with firearms. Bertrand said there were no threats or crimes committed but the group at the protest was concerned because of the violence that occurred at the 4th precinct in Minneapolis in November of 2015. I told Bertrand we had stopped a group of white males near the protest who were legally armed with firearms. Bertrand informed me he wanted police to be vigilant in the area as he did not want any violence. Bertrand told me he was talking to me from out of state but because of this role as a leader of the movement.
