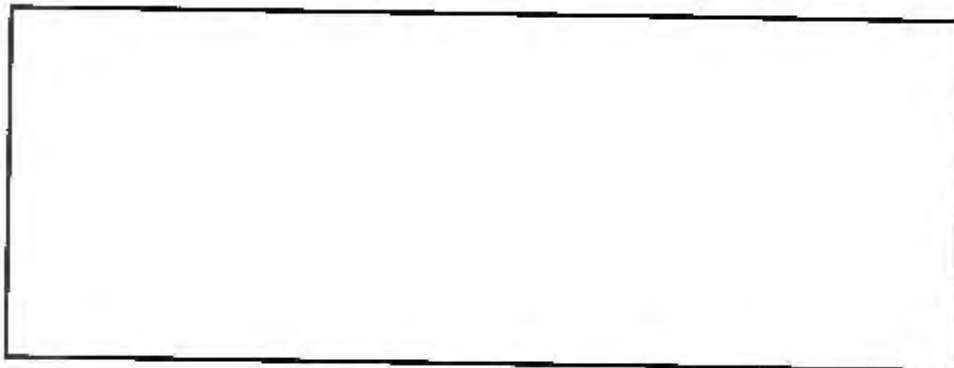

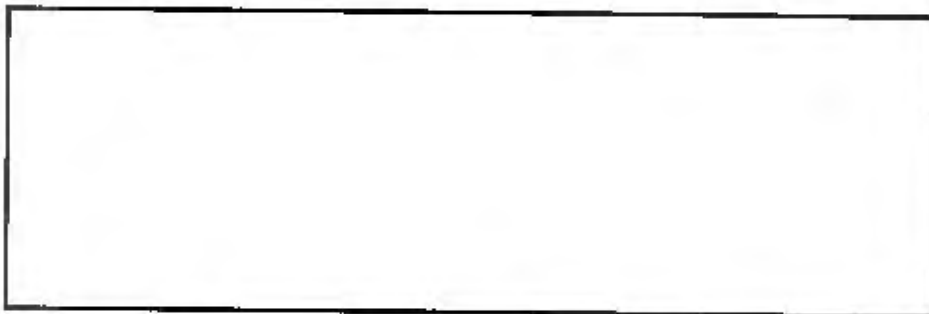

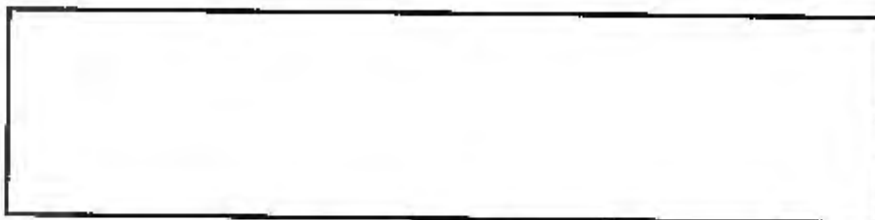

<http://www.rncwelcomingcommittee.org> under the webpage titled, "Who We Are/Points of Unity" the RNCWC is described as follows: "The RNC Welcoming Committee is an anarchist/anti-authoritarian organizing body formed to prepare for the 2008 Republican National Convention in St. Paul, Minnesota. The RNC-WC, composed primarily of Twin Cities-based anarchists and anti-authoritarians, will function as an informational clearinghouse and organize a spokes council for RNC resistance. We will coordinate logistics (food, housing, transportation), and engage in education and outreach. Without falling prey to centralized, hierarchical tendencies that have dominated such convergences in the past, we hope that the RNC-WC will maintain a unified, anti-authoritarian presence at the 2008 RNC. Our numbers are huge, and it's time that our actions reflected that."

The Internet website:

<http://www.unconventionalaction.org> provides the following "Points of Unity" to describe acceptable adoption of the term Unconventional Action by like-minded individuals and/or groups: The name Unconventional Action is available to all who: Reject all forms of hierarchy including capitalism, party communism, patriarchy, white supremacy, colonialism, and so-called representational politics. Organize on a non-hierarchical, consensus-basis that promotes autonomy, solidarity, grass-roots involvement, and the agency of those most affected by each decision. Embrace a diversity of tactics. Do not condemn any action on the grounds that it is illegal alone.

The term "Unconventional Action" may be used both to describe a particular group of individuals working toward a common goal in a specific community and a wider movement of otherwise un-associated individuals and groups also working toward a common goal. This same Internet website provides the following explanation of the movement's purpose: What is Unconventional Action? Unconventional Action is an emerging network aiming to complement the work of local organizers in Denver and the Twin Cities with regional organizing throughout the rest of the country. Our goal is to build a horizontal, inclusive framework for protests that will disrupt the upcoming Democratic and Republican National Conventions. We are currently

organizing meetings, propaganda, and consultas in our communities and encourage those in other regions to do the same.

Unconventional Action may also be serving as an umbrella organization for regional groups adopting the "Points of Unity" noted above. The UA website lists thirteen different organizations as "Unconventional Contacts". Of these thirteen organizations, six have a regional or city name in their moniker.

In addition, two of these regional groups are using email accounts based on the UA Internet account.

While UA and RNCWC are two distinct groups, much of the membership appears to be intertwined and further delineation of members at this time is impossible.

Membership in anarchist "groups" is not exclusive. UA, RNCWC, and Crimethinc as discussed in this communication are three separate groups, each with their own web site(s) and contact email addresses. Individuals and sub-groups associated with them vacillate between identifying with either one at any given time. This non-traditional approach to group membership makes it convenient for individuals to deny association with the group whenever necessary.

"Caucus of the Future":

Early in January 2008, a two-day long anarchist-oriented convention called "Caucus of the Future" was held in Des Moines, Iowa.

To this regard, the UA-Midwest website has posted a topic titled, "RNC 'Adopt a Delegate'". In this posting UA - Midwest states the following, "Unconventional Action Midwest invites all autonomous groups and individuals to 'adopt a delegate' in preparation for the Republican National Convention taking place in St. Paul September 1-4. How does it work? Easy! Simply choose a hotel and do what you can to make the delegate experience in the Twin Cities an unforgettable one!" A link on this web page identifies the specific hotels for the delegates by the state they represent. Additionally, the UA-Midwest posting states, "In congruence with the RNC Welcoming Committee's Points of Unity and the historic St. Paul Principles, UA-Midwest respects and encourages a wide variety of tactics."

Anarchist groups sometimes urge their members to commit criminal acts on behalf of the movement, while maintaining a safe distance which protects the leadership and the organization from liability. Some members of anarchist groups advocate the use of violence and criminal acts to further their political / social agenda(s).

Representatives from the United States Attorneys Office (USAO) for the Southern District of Iowa (SDI) have been briefed on the investigation, the intended goals, objectives and strategies to be carried out in order to detect, prevent and prosecute the criminal activities of the WRR and its members. Based upon the information developed thus far and through consultation with the USAO representatives, the potential federal criminal statutes which may be most feasible to pursue have been identified as Title 18, USC 241 - Conspiracy Against Rights and Title 18, USC 245 - Federally Protected Activities. The USAO / SDI has stated their support of opening a criminal investigation into this matter and their assistance with the use of all

appropriate investigative techniques to identify any criminal activity.

Based upon the information gathered to date concerning [redacted] apparent [redacted] in the WRR, [redacted] with what appear to be anarchist extremist individuals/groups, their apparent willingness to risk arrest at the RNC conceivably by violating the criminal laws of the United States or of any state therein by using force or violence in order to further their political or social goals, Omaha Division feels information exists to necessitate a PI investigation into the activities of [redacted]


