Additionally additionally we have some activism this weekend so I'm looking forward to promoting that. We've got some happening basically the next few months are going to be pretty good for us. So I would strongly encourage you guys to get out there and do activism work with your chapter leader if your job the leader doesn't have any plans for activism. You can come to me and tell me that you want to do something.

There's a lot of activism you can do without showing your face. I understand people have OPSEC concerns obviously. So just keep that in mind. Look at what G.I. does. Look at what it's just. Just look at you read Beautiful Trouble again. There are many like displays that you can create memorials where you can hang a banner without anyone having your face in the shot or you can wear sunglasses and hat relaxing from that is pretty rare for most of all I E history. We had like minimal to any DOCSIS it just almost didn't happen. And obviously the issue is online OPSEC more than anything else. So you know there has there does appear to have been a recent infiltration unicorn Riot has hinted that there is going to be another lease of stuff. We'll see what comes of it. But you know given the auto deletion and just people not posting personal info on there I'm not terribly concerned obviously if there is evidence that someone has gotten in. We will need to you know I think we're going to have to institute some pretty drastic changes because if something's not working it's not working. And so.
