I met with Strom for about 10 minutes this morning while you were on your grants webinar. Here's the highlights:

- A J3 taskforce workshop is currently tentatively planned for July 26-28. They plan on inviting NEMA.
- During fiscal year 2022, they are looking at burn/ firefighting group training at various NGNE training facilities across the state, in coordination with local fire departments. No additional details available.

- Minnesota EMAC: I let him know about the possible EMAC request for 40 NSP troopers to Minnesota, as that will potentially make Lincoln and Omaha request more NGNE resources to address NSP resource limitations. Also, of note, they'll both be in Omaha this afternoon coordinating plans that hopefully won't be needed.

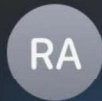
