This story caught me by surprise as well when I was perusing the headlines Sunday evening. I cannot speak as to why the RapidDeploy notification was not triggered, but only speculate that they are using that platform for civil unrest type events. I will connect with the Communications/Technology subcommittee chair to verify their protocols. I did sit on the PIO call yesterday and the NLTF PIO was asked for a press release by the media and the energy company in response to an advocate press release and the conscious decision was made not to release anything on behalf of the task force feeling that it fell outside the purview and was directly linked to the energy company. I can attempt to explain more on today's call.
