**NARRATIVE**

On 13 December 2022, I, Officer G Sey, was involved in a joint Georgia Bureau of Investigation (GBI) and Atlanta Police Department (APD) detail at the building site of the new academy. During the course of the detail, agents and officers encountered three trespassers in three separate treehouses. The first was near the south pond (near 1313 Key Rd SE) - the treehouse consisted of a wooden platform, wooden roof, and tarp walls. The second was about 300 yards northwest of Metro Youth Detention Center (1300 Constitution Rd SE) - wooden platform, tarp walls and roof. The third was about 50 yards northwest of Metro YDC - wooden platform, tarp walls and roof.

Upon encountering a trespasser at the first treehouse, the GBI, in conjunction with the Strategic Response Section (SRS), ordered the occupant, a white female later identified as [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED] 97), to vacate the tree by giving the standard APD dispersal order. [REDACTED] refused to comply and come down. At that point, GBI and SRS ordered chemical agent to be used in the treehouse in an attempt have her surrender without further incident. [REDACTED] was provided numerous warnings, offers of assistance to get down, and provided with safe routes of egress. However, [REDACTED] continually refused to get down and said, "No," when ordered to get down.

At this point, Sgt SN Krieger was ordered to deploy chemical agent into the treehouse using a city-issued PepperBall Launcher. While Lt Thomas and the GBI gave numerous commands, Sgt Krieger fired one PepperBall at a time into the treehouse and awaited a response from [REDACTED]. However, [REDACTED] refused to have a dialogue with GBI agents and refused to surrender. Sgt Krieger gradually increased the amount of PepperBall agent in the treehouse in hopes that [REDACTED] would surrender. After it was determined the PepperBall agent was ineffective, APD SWAT arrived and took over all chemical munitions. During the incident, [REDACTED] was observed with a knife in her hand that she dropped to the ground after being given orders to drop the knife. [REDACTED] eventually used a rope to lower herself to the ground where she was taken into custody without further incident.

Afterwards, the group of officers and agents moved to the second occupied treehouse. Again, the same procedure was followed as Lt Thomas gave the dispersal order and provided numerous opportunities for the trespasser, a white male later identified as [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED] 00), to peacefully surrender. [REDACTED] refused to come down and repeatedly said, "Fuck the police." SRS then ordered chemical agents to be deployed. At that time, Sgt Krieger used the PepperBall launcher to administer several PepperBalls into the treehouse. APD SWAT took over chemical munitions and [REDACTED] eventually lowered himself to the ground and surrendered without further incident.

Afterwards, the group of officers and agents moved to the third occupied treehouse. Upon arrival, the trespasser, a black male later identified as [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED] /2000), could be seen dancing to music inside the treehouse. As done previously, Lt Thomas gave multiple commands for [REDACTED] to disperse which he refused. SRS then ordered chemical agents to be deployed. At that time, Sgt Krieger again used the PepperBall launcher to administer multiple PepperBalls into the treehouse. APD SWAT also used chemical munitions in an attempt to have [REDACTED] surrender. Eventually, [REDACTED] came down and surrendered to waiting officers.

I furthermore, acted in an assistance capacity and did not use force.

All arrestees were offered medical assistance and custody was transferred to GBI agents on scene for processing. Evidence was recovered and secured by GBI and APD Homeland Security.

**NARRATIVE**

On 12/13/22, I, Sgt SN Krieger, 7006, worked a joint GBI-APD detail at the new academy build site. During this detail, agents and officers encountered three trespassers in separate treehouses (one in each, three arrestees total) on Atlanta property.

The first treehouse was located near the south pond adjacent to Key Rd. The trespasser inside was later identified as [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED] 97, W/F). The treehouse consisted of a wooden platform base, wooden roof, and tarp walls concealing [REDACTED] inside. While officers and agents were on the ground below, we could hear [REDACTED] talking as if she was talking to someone on her cell phone. We could not see [REDACTED] and feared that she may be armed with a knife or other weapon - trespassers on site are known to carry knives, hatchets, wrist rocket slingshots with metal ball bearings, molotov cocktails, and firearm magazines and shell casings have been recovered on site as well. Based on the potential for weapons, it was determined that officers should not climb the tree in an attempt to take [REDACTED] into custody inside the treehouse. The GBI and APD gave multiple commands for [REDACTED] to come down and she replied, "no." I was then ordered via radio by Maj Harper to proceed with the operational plan (specifically, using the PepperBall launcher to introduce PepperBall chemical agent into the treehouses).

I used caution when firing PepperBall rounds into the treehouse by targeting areas that it would be unlikely for [REDACTED] to be in. Throughout the operation, I gradually introduced chemical agent into the treehouse and paused after deployments to give [REDACTED] an opportunity to surrender. GBI agents continually gave [REDACTED] commands to surrender, attempted to negotiate with her, and offered her assistance getting safely down, food, water, and medical aid. [REDACTED] occasionally talked back to GBI agents but refused to surrender. After firing multiple rounds, the Pepperball Launcher was determined to be ineffective in getting [REDACTED] to surrender. At that point, APD SWAT responded to the scene and took over deployment of chemical agents.

During SWAT's deployment, [REDACTED] could be seen holding a knife in her hand. Officers gave her commands to drop the knife and she dropped it to the ground. After additional commands were given from officers on the ground and from the Air Unit's public announcement speaker, [REDACTED] lowered herself down to the ground using ropes where she was taken into custody without further incident. [REDACTED] was handcuffed by Sgt B Hill.

The second treehouse was located near the west side of the Metropolitan Youth Detention Center (Metro YDC) off Constitution Rd SE. The trespasser inside was later identified as [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED] 00, W/M). The treehouse consisted of a wooden platform base and tarp walls and roof (cone shaped) concealing [REDACTED] inside. [REDACTED] occasionally stuck his head outside the tarp and he could be seen wearing a respirator mask. [REDACTED] also said, "Fuck the police," numerous times while officers gave him commands to climb down. Again, fearing [REDACTED] may be armed, it was determined unsafe for officers to go up to get him down. Lt Thomas gave numerous commands for [REDACTED] to surrender but he refused. Lt Thomas continually gave [REDACTED] commands to surrender, attempted to negotiate with him, and offered him assistance getting safely down, food, water, and medical aid. At that point, Lt Thomas ordered SWAT to deploy chemical agent into the treehouse.

After firing a few rounds, [REDACTED] began to surrender and lowered himself partially down from the treehouse using his rope. [REDACTED] stopped descending when a firework mortar detonated in the woods in close proximity to officers on the perimeter. I gave him verbal commands to continue descending, but [REDACTED] began to ascend back toward the treehouse. I then fired one PepperBall round into the platform above [REDACTED] to get him to surrender which he did. [REDACTED] lowered himself to the ground where he was taken into custody without further incident. [REDACTED] was handcuffed by Ofc M Ware.

The third treehouse was located near the west side of Metro YDC, just south of the second treehouse. The trespasser was later identified as [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]/00, B/M). The treehouse consisted of a wooden platform base and tarp walls and roof (cone shaped) concealing [REDACTED] inside. [REDACTED] was playing music, dancing, and periodically stuck his head out to yell at police. Lt Thomas continually gave [REDACTED] commands to surrender, attempted to negotiate with him, and offered him assistance getting safely down, food, water, and medical aid. However, [REDACTED] refused to surrender and then concealed himself inside the treehouse. Again, fearing [REDACTED] may be armed, it was determined unsafe for officers to go up to get him down. At that point, Lt Thomas ordered the deployment of chemical agent into the treehouse.

I used caution when firing PepperBall rounds into the treehouse by targeting areas that it would be unlikely for [REDACTED] to be in. I gradually introduced chemical agent into the treehouse and paused periodically to give [REDACTED] an opportunity to surrender. Also, SWAT deployed chemical agent into the treehouse to increase the effects in hopes that [REDACTED] would surrender. Despite numerous commands to surrender and offerings of assistance getting down, food, water, and medical aid, [REDACTED] continued to conceal himself in the treehouse. Additionally, the Air Unit used their public announcement speaker to give commands, but [REDACTED] refused to comply with commands and surrender. After some time, the tarps were removed from the treehouse exposing [REDACTED], and at that point, officers were able to see that [REDACTED] was roped into the tree and that it would be highly unlikely that he could fall. Additionally, officers were able to see that [REDACTED] was armed with what appeared to be two hatchets (one on each hip attached to his belt). Because of this heightened risk and because [REDACTED] showed no signs of surrendering, it was determined that direct impact rounds would be the next course of action to force [REDACTED] to surrender.

When targeting [REDACTED] for direct impact PepperBalls, I intentionally avoided his face, neck, head, and groin in accordance with PepperBall recommendations. The direct impact rounds were effective at first, and [REDACTED] began to surrender. However, as he began rigging his gear to descend, he continued to stall for an extended period of time and stopped complying. SWAT and I used a combination of tools and techniques to eventually force [REDACTED] to comply with commands. [REDACTED] eventually rigged his rope to descend, and he was assisted to the ground by one of the contracted arborers who was on scene to dismantle the treehouses. [REDACTED] was handcuffed by Sgt C McGhee.

**NARRATIVE**

On 12/13/2022, the Atlanta SWAT(Special Weapons and Tactics) Unit was requested to assist in a joint detail with GBI(Georgia Bureau of Investigation) and APD(Atlanta Police Department) at 1327 Key Road. I, Sergeant C. M. Brown, along with several SWAT officers responded to the command post to assist with the detail and to receive instructions.

Upon deploying to the first location where [REDACTED] was located, SWAT Officer J. Caporaso took over the less lethal deployment. Officer J. Caporaso utilized a 40mm launcher to deploy chemical agents in the area of [REDACTED]. The 40mm was aimed at the wooden platform in order to disperse the chemical agent effectively. Once [REDACTED] lowered herself down to the ground, she was arrested and she was taken to EMS(Emergency Medical Services) personnel, however she refused treatment.

At the second location SWAT Officer D. Grooms provided less lethal deployment once [REDACTED] refused to comply with verbal commands from Lieutenant R. Thomas. SWAT Officer D. Grooms deployed chemical agents into the tree bark next to the opening of the treehouse, which allowed the chemical agents to disperse effectively. After deploying the chemical agents [REDACTED] appeared from within the treehouse and began to tie himself in, to descend down to the ground. After being taken into custody [REDACTED] was taken to EMS personnel, however he refused treatment.

At the third location SWAT Officers D. Grooms and P. Kane deployed less lethal assistance once [REDACTED] refused to comply with verbal commands from Lieutenant R. Thomas. Officer D. Grooms used the 40mm launcher to deploy chemical agents in the area of [REDACTED]. The 40mm was aimed at the trees next to the treehouse which allowed the chemical agents to disperse effectively. Officer D. Grooms also used one direct impact round from the 40mm for compliance once [REDACTED] was known to be tied into his ropes safely once his platform was removed, which aided in him coming down from the tree. Officer D. Grooms also used one direct impact round on the wooden platform and one on the suspects bookbag to dislodge it from the platform. At the third location Officer P. Kane used chemical agent cannisters which were inside of a metal container to aide in compliance, however the wind pushed the agent away from the suspect. Once the suspect was placed into custody he was transported to Grady Hospital for treatment for possible bruising.
