**(PROPOSED) ORDER GRANTING
 DEFENDANT RYAN LONDREGAN'S
 MOTION TO DISMISS THE STATE'S
 COMPLAINT OR, ALTERNATIVELY,
 DISQUALIFY THE HENNEPIN COUNTY
 ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FOR ABUSE OF
 THE GRAND-JURY PROCESS**

Before the Court is Defendant Ryan Londregan's Motion to Dismiss the State's Complaint or, Alternatively, Disqualify the Hennepin County Attorney's Office for Abuse of the Grand-Jury Process (the "Motion"), in that the State charged Defendant via complaint after the grand jury failed to return an indictment and used the grand jury as a substitute for discovery.

Based on all the files, documents, evidence and argument, and with the benefit of a hearing, the Court finds that the State abused the grand jury process by using it for an improper purpose—i.e, as a substitute for discovery. Once the State empaneled the grand jury, it was required to proceed via indictment. In the absence of such an indictment, the case should be dismissed. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that Defendant's Motion is GRANTED. The Complaint in this matter is DISMISSED.
