

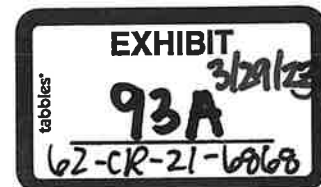

15 SGT. ZEBRO: Hi.
16
17 KJELLBERG: Hey. Sorry.
18
19 SGT. ZEBRO: Oh. No worries. Do you want more room on that side of the table?
20
21 KJELLBERG: No. I'm all right. I appreciate it.
22
23 SGT. ZEBRO: And actually I got a bunch of room here.
24
25 KJELLBERG: Yeah. That - yeah they make it that way. You know?
26
27 SGT. ZEBRO: Oh no. I don't mind at all. So real quick - we...
28
29 KJELLBERG: I'll just finish that. There's some left in here.
30
31 SGT. ZEBRO: If I didn't tell you, my name is Dan Zebro with the - we do all the, like,
32 robberies, assaults...
33
34 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Yep.
35
36 SGT. ZEBRO: ...homicides and everything like that.
37
38 KJELLBERG: Yep.
39
40 SGT. ZEBRO: And I'm one of the investigators so I wanna talk to ya.
41
42 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
43
44 SGT. ZEBRO: And it sounds like you were bein' cooperative out there...

46 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
47
48 SGT. ZEBRO: ...with the officers. Um, so I wanna try to get the whole story but...
49
50 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
51
52 SGT. ZEBRO: My understanding is they Mirandized you so I'm gonna read that again.
53
54 KJELLBERG: Yep.
55
56 SGT. ZEBRO: Make sure we go through that.
57
58 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Oh. Yeah. I, uh, definitely.
59
60 SGT. ZEBRO: Before we go through that.
61
62 KJELLBERG: No. Um, I can't remember his last name but Chad read it no problem.
63
64 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. So, let's do that real quick. It's, uh, December 2, 2021. What's your
65 first name?
66
67 KJELLBERG: Brian. B-R-I-A-N.
68
69 SGT. ZEBRO: What's your middle name Brian?
70
71 KJELLBERG: Harry. H-A-R-R-Y. K-J-E-L-L-B-E-R-G and it does have a Swedish
72 thing.
73
74 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. Is that right? Alright, Brian, how old are you?
75
76 KJELLBERG: Uh, 50 - yeah. 50.
77
78 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. What's your date of birth?
79
80 KJELLBERG: 9-28-71.
81
82 SGT. ZEBRO: And what - what's a good address for ya?
83
84 KJELLBERG: 17-20 7th Street East 55106.
85
86 SGT. ZEBRO: And are you married or single?
87
88 KJELLBERG: Single.
89
90 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. And what's a good phone number for ya?

91
92 KJELLBERG: 651-755-0147. I would - I would say it's good. I don't know - I don't have
93 it.
94
95 SGT. ZEBRO: Why? Wa- was your phone in the vehicle?
96
97 KJELLBERG: Well, no. So, they took it.
98
99 SGT. ZEBRO: Oh. Really? The cops have it?
100
101 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
102
103 SGT. ZEBRO: Oh. Okay. Uh, I'm tryin' to find...
104
105 KJELLBERG: So, don't - don't - don't - don't try to call me.
106
107 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. 0147?
108
109 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
110
111 SGT. ZEBRO: Are you workin' right now?
112
113 KJELLBERG: No. I am retired.
114
115 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
116
117 KJELLBERG: I, uh, had some medical issues and I had just quit working.
118
119 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. What's the last grade in school you completed?
120
121 KJELLBERG: Uh, Associates Degree.
122
123 SGT. ZEBRO: Associates? So that'd be, like ta...
124
125 KJELLBERG: 14.
126
127 SGT. ZEBRO: ...14 years now? Where was the Associates at?
128
129 KJELLBERG: Uh, Century College.
130
131 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
132
133 KJELLBERG: The old 916.
134
135 SGT. ZEBRO: Alright, Brian. Real quick - you have the right to protection against self-
136 incrimination within the law. Please read along with the officer and initial

137 each statement if you understand it. So, I'll read these to you. If you
138 understand just initial. Okay? Number 1 - you have the right to remain
139 silent and refuse at any time to answer any questions by a police officer.
140 Do you understand that?
141
142 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
143
144 SGT. ZEBRO: Initial right there.
145
146 KJELLBERG: Okay.
147
148 SGT. ZEBRO: Two, anything you do or say can be used against you. Three, you have the
149 right to talk to a lawyer and have that lawyer with you during any
150 questioning and - or if you cannot afford a lawyer one will be appointed
151 for you and you can remain silent until you talk to the lawyer.
152
153 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm. Okay.
154
155 SGT. ZEBRO: If you have an understand of all the rights that I've read to you you initial
156 each par- paragraph just to show you understand each of your rights.
157
158 KJELLBERG: Okay.
159
160 SGT. ZEBRO: And I'll give ya a copy at the end of the interview. Okay?
161
162 KJELLBERG: Y- no problem. Thank you.
163
164 SGT. ZEBRO: Do you understand all that?
165
166 KJELLBERG: Oh. Yeah.
167
168 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. (Unintelligible) Okay?
169
170 KJELLBERG: M...
171
172 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, so from the beginning here...
173
174 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
175
176 SGT. ZEBRO: ...You live at 1720 7th Street right?
177
178 KJELLBERG: The old fire station.
179
180 SGT. ZEBRO: At the old fire station?
181
182 KJELLBERG: Yep. I bought it about seven years ago.

183
184 SGT. ZEBRO: Is that a whole house?
185
186 KJELLBERG: That - yeah. I just live a- I live there.
187
188 SGT. ZEBRO: I mean, it's not, like, multiple apartments or...
189
190 KJELLBERG: No.
191
192 SGT. ZEBRO: ...anything like that?
193
194 KJELLBERG: It's just me.
195
196 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
197
198 KJELLBERG: Single person. Actually (unintelligible)
199
200 SGT. ZEBRO: And you've lived there how long?
201
202 KJELLBERG: About seven years - six - seven years.
203
204 SGT. ZEBRO: And you own it?
205
206 KJELLBERG: Yes.
207
208 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. So, it's a fire station that faces on 7th Street...
209
210 KJELLBERG: Yes.
211
212 SGT. ZEBRO: ...and then...
213
214 KJELLBERG: My room is on the side.
215
216 SGT. ZEBRO: Where it goes on the side (unintelligible)
217
218 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Alley.
219
220 SGT. ZEBRO: ...alley?
221
222 KJELLBERG: Yep.
223
224 SGT. ZEBRO: Well, do you have a - a parking lot in the back?
225
226 KJELLBERG: Yep. You park in the - the - I think the whole east side of the whole
227 parking lot.
228

229 SGT. ZEBRO: Parking on the east side?
230
231 KJELLBERG: Well, it's a yard - my yard.
232
233 SGT. ZEBRO: A parking lot in the rear?
234
235 KJELLBERG: Well, it's - there's enough room for parking. Yeah.
236
237 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
238
239 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
240
241 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
242
243 KJELLBERG: Mm it's sort of - I mean, if you- if you look at a map or whatever you can
244 - it's easy to see.
245
246 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
247
248 KJELLBERG: M-m- there's parking there.
249
250 SGT. ZEBRO: So sorry. I write a lot of stuff down...
251
252 KJELLBERG: No worries.
253
254 SGT. ZEBRO: because I don't wanna forget.
255
256 KJELLBERG: No worries.
257
258 SGT. ZEBRO: And I may ask you some questions that...
259
260 KJELLBERG: There's also three signs right there - no trespassing, no parking, private
261 property.
262
263 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you have three signs...
264
265 KJELLBERG: Yes.
266
267 SGT. ZEBRO: ...that say no trespassing?
268
269 KJELLBERG: No parking and private property. I've been dealin' with this for five plus
270 years, six years.
271
272 SGT. ZEBRO: Alright. So, when you're saying you have the signs just - the signs in the
273 back of the ha-, uh...
274

275 KJELLBERG: Yes.
276
277 SGT. ZEBRO: Oh.
278
279 KJELLBERG: Yes.
280
281 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
282
283 KJELLBERG: Right where everybody wants to park.
284
285 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. And you said you've been dealing with what?
286
287 KJELLBERG: The neighbors...
288
289 SGT. ZEBRO: The neighbors?
290
291 KJELLBERG: The neighbor's - the neighbor's friends. Not the neighbors themselves but
292 friends of the neighbors or what you wanna call that - associates of the
293 neighbors, um, continuously park in my driveway. I've asked multiple
294 times the neighbors to don't let their friends park there.
295
296 SGT. ZEBRO: Where - where - what neighbors or is it all your neighbors?
297
298 KJELLBERG: Well, it's - it's Josh which is the - right next door. Uh, you- he's dealt with
299 the police many of times. Uh, what the hell is his last name? 1730 I think
300 is his address.
301
302 SGT. ZEBRO: 7th Street?
303
304 KJELLBERG: Yes. I can't think of his last name right now.
305
306 SGT. ZEBRO: His friends are parking there or he's parking there?
307
308 KJELLBERG: His friends. He used to - used to.
309
310 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
311
312 KJELLBERG: Um, and now the house next - just to the east of his, uh, just got bought
313 and people come and go all the time and that's where this individual was
314 coming from, uh, this evening.
315
316 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
317
318 KJELLBERG: He does not live there, um, that I know of.
319
320 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. So, you got these, "No Parking," signs?

321
322 KJELLBERG: Yep.
323
324 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, you got a lot of people parking there all the time, right?
325
326 KJELLBERG: It's - it's gotten less but it happens now and then.
327
328 SGT. ZEBRO: Have you called the police a lot over that?
329
330 KJELLBERG: Yes.
331
332 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
333
334 KJELLBERG: Police. Look it up.
335
336 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
337
338 KJELLBERG: Right. Just please look it up.
339
340 SGT. ZEBRO: Was it, like, over the last five years then?
341
342 KJELLBERG: No. No.
343
344 SGT. ZEBRO: Over when?
345
346 KJELLBERG: Uh, actually it hasn't happened in the last probably six months - at least
347 six months. Um, if I had my phone I could look at the calendar and I could
348 tell ya.
349
350 SGT. ZEBRO: Oh. It's okay but, uh, we - we can look it up.
351
352 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
353
354 SGT. ZEBRO: So, called a lot in the past for parking issues?
355
356 KJELLBERG: Yes. Yes. M- multiple times.
357
358 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
359
360 KJELLBERG: Um...
361
362 SGT. ZEBRO: So...
363
364 KJELLBERG: If you also ask Officer Rangel...
365
366 SGT. ZEBRO: Mm-hmm.

367
368 KJELLBERG: ...and Officer Sands, they have prior knowledge as well.
369
370 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Um, so then tonight - what happened tonight now, like, what was...
371
372 KJELLBERG: I was...
373
374 SGT. ZEBRO: ...the person...
375
376 KJELLBERG: I was leaving my house. I was gonna go to my girlfriend's and walked
377 outside and was just like, "Whoa." Like, "What - what the hell's here?"
378
379 SGT. ZEBRO: What time do you think this was at?
380
381 KJELLBERG: Right after 7, 7...7:05, maybe - I don't know right - and I just waited.
382
383 SGT. ZEBRO: And what'd you see out in...
384
385 KJELLBERG: I...burgundy Mercedes SUV.
386
387 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you were going to leave to go to your girlfriend's house?
388
389 KJELLBERG: Yes. Yep. And I'm just waiting, waiting, waiting. Um...
390
391 SGT. ZEBRO: Where was it parked?
392
393 KJELLBERG: It was facing east right outside my backdoor on my property right next to
394 the sign that says, "No Parking. Private Property." Probably within three
395 feet of the sign.
396
397 SGT. ZEBRO: Alright. So, it wasn't your car. You didn't even park there but you're
398 figuring okay someone parked here?
399
400 KJELLBERG: Yep. Yep.
401
402 SGT. ZEBRO: Yep?
403
404 KJELLBERG: And as I was waiting there, um, my one neighbor - the - the officers know
405 him very well - Eastside Jimmy, um, he's all over the place.
406
407 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.
408
409 KJELLBERG: He called and he said, "Hey I just see, uh, your - there's a vehicle parked
410 in your driveway."
411
412 SGT. ZEBRO: Mm-hmm.

413
414 KJELLBERG: You know? He goes, "Can I - can, you know," - I'm like, "Yeah. I'm - I'm
415 just waiting." Um, so, you know, talk - he - he's seen it as well. Um, I
416 waited probably another ten minutes and then I called the police regular
417 non-emergency number. Oh, I'm sorry.
418
419 SGT. ZEBRO: Yep. So, you said you waited about ten minutes?
420
421 KJELLBERG: M- five or ten minutes I called the police.
422
423 SGT. ZEBRO: When you said the non-emergency num- what number...
424
425 KJELLBERG: Uh, it was...
426
427 SGT. ZEBRO: ...did you call?
428
429 KJELLBERG: ...266-1234. I think that's what is it. Yes. I thought it was 1212 and then I
430 just let it ring and I was like, "No. That's not it." I had to look it up.
431
432 SGT. ZEBRO: And what'd you tell - what'd you call and tell them?
433
434 KJELLBERG: I said, "I have a vehicle on my property. I have no idea who's it is and I
435 want it ticketed and towed," and they said, "We will send somebody out."
436 Um, a- and I said, "Okay. Thank you," and after that I tried calling a tow
437 truck company. I just - just, like, Googled, "Tow truck," or whatever, um,
438 called the first number. I don't even know who it was and they said, "You
439 know, we don't do residential," but I talked to him for, like, a minute or
440 two, you know, gave him my address and all that and he goes, "Yeah. We
441 don't do residential." Um, I said, "Okay. Well thank you." I said, "Who do
442 you recommend," um, and he said, "Absolute or Budget," or whatever so I
443 called Budget and - but and I said, "Yeah. No problem." I said, you know,
444 I told them the situation. I said, "Cops are on the way to ticket it and...
445
446 SGT. ZEBRO: Mm-hmm.
447
448 KJELLBERG: ...I know that they're not gonna tow it.
449
450 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
451
452 KJELLBERG: So, I have to call the tow company.
453
454 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
455
456 KJELLBERG: So called them and they showed up before the cops did.
457
458 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. So, was it Budget that showed up?

459
460 KJELLBERG: Yes. Yes.
461
462 SGT. ZEBRO: Um...
463
464 KJELLBERG: So obviously it's - I've still been waiting quite - quite a while.
465
466 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. Okay.
467
468 KJELLBERG: Um, and so I'm just waiting outside and...
469
470 SGT. ZEBRO: The tow truck shows up?
471
472 KJELLBERG: Nope. Nope. A- at first initially two cars leave the house two doors down
473 'cause I can see the brake lights, eh, down the alley.
474
475 SGT. ZEBRO: And wu- when you're talkin' two doors down...
476
477 KJELLBERG: So, like, headed to the east.
478
479 SGT. ZEBRO: Do you know what the address is there?
480
481 KJELLBERG: I do not. Uh, probably 1740 maybe. I mean, I know - I know the woman
482 who owns it. I can't think of her name right now but she works at the VA.
483 I see her when I go to my dental appointments.
484
485 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you waited and two cars leave?
486
487 KJELLBERG: Yep. Two cars leave, um, and then probably another couple - two or three
488 minutes after that maybe - maybe five - I don't know, um, a gentleman
489 comes trotting down the s- the alley, um, onto my property and I said,
490 "Stay off my property." He goes, "Well I have to - I have to get my
491 vehicle," and I...
492
493 SGT. ZEBRO: So, a guy - about five minutes later...
494
495 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
496
497 SGT. ZEBRO: ...a guy - did he run from this - where this - did he leave from where this
498 car is backed up?
499
500 KJELLBERG: Right. Right. Yeah.
501
502 SGT. ZEBRO: About five minutes later, uh...
503
504 KJELLBERG: Yeah.

505
506 SGT. ZEBRO: Uh, a guy comes?
507
508 KJELLBERG: Yep.
509
510 SGT. ZEBRO: One second.
511
512 KJELLBERG: Yep. No problem. Thank you.
513
514 SGT. ZEBRO: Was this the guy you have the altercation with?
515
516 KJELLBERG: Yes. Yes.
517
518 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, and he said, "I have to get my vehicle."?
519
520 KJELLBERG: Uh, well he goes - well I said - I actually asked him three or four times. I
521 said, "Can you just stay off my property?" He keeps on coming. He keeps
522 on coming and I said, "Get off my property." Um, he kept on approaching.
523 He goes, "I - I - what about my truck or my - my truck or, you know,
524 vehicle or whatever - car?" Um, I said, "It's on private - it's on my
525 property." I said, "There's three signs right here, "No Trespassing", "No
526 Parking," "Private Property."
527
528 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. One second.
529
530 KJELLBERG: Yep.
531
532 SGT. ZEBRO: Alright. I just - like I said my memory's...
533
534 KJELLBERG: No.
535
536 SGT. ZEBRO: ...bad. So, I do...
537
538 KJELLBERG: No worries. No worries.
539
540 SGT. ZEBRO: ...apologize.
541
542 KJELLBERG: Yep.
543
544 SGT. ZEBRO: And you - you said the sign here on that spot right there?
545
546 KJELLBERG: There is a sign here, "No parking," "No Trespassing," whatever. I said, "I
547 called the cops. And the tow truck people are on the way." He literally just
548 reached back and just clocked me, um, probably four or five times. Oh.
549 Actually, sorry, before that he goes, um, uh, so the - somethin' -
550 somethin', "Nigger," - "Get out of my way, nigger," or somethin' to me.

551
552 SGT. ZEBRO: And then he punched you four or five times?
553
554 KJELLBERG: Uh, and - nope. I- right after that I said, "I'm not your nigger," to back hi-
555 to him and then that's when he just cold clocked me fo- probably four or
556 five times. I didn't even know what was happening.
557
558 SGT. ZEBRO: With a fist or what?
559
560 KJELLBERG: Yes.
561
562 SGT. ZEBRO: Where wu- where did he hit you?
563
564 KJELLBERG: Uh, on my face here. I got one on my jaw over here. Um...
565
566 SGT. ZEBRO: So, your left side of the face?
567
568 KJELLBERG: The - my left side and my right jaw - whatever. Um, to give you a little
569 history. I had a TBI roughly two years ago so I'm concerned, uh, about
570 repetitive blows to my head.
571
572 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
573
574 KJELLBERG: Um, so in my pocket I had a - I don't know what you wanna call it - it's
575 just a - it's a stainless-steel tube with a handle on it. Um...
576
577 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
578
579 KJELLBERG: Yep and I just to da-, you know, to the side. Um, he hit me one more time.
580 I fell back on a pile of rocks.
581
582 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. So, you said, um, he punches you...
583
584 KJELLBERG: Yep.
585
586 SGT. ZEBRO: ...four or five times the left side of your face...
587
588 KJELLBERG: Yep. Right.
589
590 SGT. ZEBRO: ...right jaw?
591
592 KJELLBERG: Yep. Right jaw on my - and then on the cheekbone up here, I guess.
593
594 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. And you said you had a TBI how long ago?
595
596 KJELLBERG: Uh, August of two years ago.

597
598 SGT. ZEBRO: What was that from?
599
600 KJELLBERG: Uh, it was actually a - I went to go pick up a friend at a bar and - and I've
601 not even d- had a drink in 20 years or at least 20 years and her mouth got
602 the best of her and she told somebody off and they came over and decided
603 to beat me up.
604
605 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
606
607 KJELLBERG: Because I was pickin' her up because she didn't wanna drive home.
608
609 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. And then you said in your coat pocket there that you got on?
610
611 KJELLBERG: Yep. Yep.
612
613 SGT. ZEBRO: What was it? You said it was some kind...
614
615 KJELLBERG: It's like a stainless-steel tube with a, uh...
616
617 SGT. ZEBRO: Like a pipe?
618
619 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Sort of like a piece of pipe just probably quarter inch diameter
620 maybe.
621
622 SGT. ZEBRO: Was it jagged or something?
623
624 KJELLBERG: It was sharp.
625
626 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah? Like, a li- so, like, a knife...
627
628 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
629
630 SGT. ZEBRO: ...kinda thing?
631
632 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Yeah.
633
634 SGT. ZEBRO: So, at that time he punches you...
635
636 KJELLBERG: Yep.
637
638 SGT. ZEBRO: ...a bunch of times, you take it out or...
639
640 KJELLBERG: Or I say - I - I - I'm tryin' to back away and he just keep on hitting me
641 I'm...
642

643 SGT. ZEBRO: And where'd you hit him with it? Do you know?
644
645 KJELLBERG: Lower stomach.
646
647 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
648
649 KJELLBERG: And he hit me one more time and I fell back in the rock pile and I drop-
650 dropped the pipe into the rocks and, uh, officers were trying to find it. I
651 don't know if they did or not.
652
653 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Ti- u- so you hit him in the gut but he punched you one more time?
654
655 KJELLBERG: Yep. And I just - then I - that's when I actually was able to pick my phone
656 up and - 'cause I had 911 on the phone already, um...
657
658 SGT. ZEBRO: Well, wait. Once - once he punched you a- again after he got...
659
660 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
661
662 SGT. ZEBRO: ...you hit him only one time?
663
664 KJELLBERG: One time.
665
666 SGT. ZEBRO: And you fell back?
667
668 KJELLBERG: After he hit me this - this...
669
670 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
671
672 KJELLBERG: ...the last time.
673
674 SGT. ZEBRO: You fall on the ground or what?
675
676 KJELLBERG: Uh, yeah. I fell on the ground behind me.
677
678 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. And where did he go at this time?
679
680 KJELLBERG: He went, uh, to the right that's all and then he went out to the street. Um,
681 and then after that then he went to-, uh, i- as I was picking the phone up.
682
683 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you dropped your phone?
684
685 KJELLBERG: Yep. Well, I dropped the phone as, uh, as he hit me.
686
687 SGT. ZEBRO: M- okay.
688

689 KJELLBERG: Um, and I wu- I had 911 on the phone right as he called me nigger I think
690 was when I actually had dialed it. Um...
691
692 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you dropped the phone so you dialed it while...
693
694 KJELLBERG: While the r- verbal col- the verbal altercation.
695
696 SGT. ZEBRO: (Unintelligible) Did anybody answer do you know?
697
698 KJELLBERG: I have nu- it was at a po- when I picked it up there was.
699
700 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
701
702 KJELLBERG: Um...
703
704 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you - so the phone falls...
705
706 KJELLBERG: Yep.
707
708 SGT. ZEBRO: Um...
709
710 KJELLBERG: Glasses, uh...
711
712 SGT. ZEBRO: Guy runs.
713
714 KJELLBERG: ...glasses are somewhere. I don't know where my glasses went.
715
716 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. What did you...
717
718 KJELLBERG: He runs to the right.
719
720 SGT. ZEBRO: ...do at that point?
721
722 KJELLBERG: He w- he walked out the right and then he went down the alley back to
723 said residence. Um, and then at that time, um, I had been talking to 911
724 and right after, I mean, not even seconds, two people come running down
725 the alley.
726
727 SGT. ZEBRO: Wait. So, you picked up the phone and there was an operator...
728
729 KJELLBERG: Yes.
730
731 SGT. ZEBRO: ...on there?
732
733 KJELLBERG: Yes. Yes. And I said, "I n- I need somebody here now." Gave them my
734 address.

735
736 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
737
738 KJELLBERG: Um...
739
740 SGT. ZEBRO: And what'd you tell them happened?
741
742 KJELLBERG: That I – I got assaulted and I need somebody here. Um, I didn't know - I
743 didn't know to what point I had - if I had injured him or not, you know, I
744 didn't know. Um, he walked away. I do- I would assume but...
745
746 SGT. ZEBRO: But you think you stabbed him?
747
748 KJELLBERG: I, uh, I had tried. I guess you'd have to ask him that. Um...
749
750 SGT. ZEBRO: What was your point when you stabbed him?
751
752 KJELLBERG: To defend myself on my own property.
753
754 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
755
756 KJELLBERG: 'Cause I really don't want another concussion.
757
758 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. So, y- you tell them that and then what do you do from there?
759
760 KJELLBERG: And he went down the alley back to the residence.
761
762 SGT. ZEBRO: Yep.
763
764 KJELLBERG: Um, as I'm talkin' to the oper- or the operator - the telecoms operator
765 whatever, uh, two individuals come down the alley and I close my door
766 and lock it.
767
768 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you were inside your house?
769
770 KJELLBERG: Yep. Yep. I didn't wanna - I didn't want nothin' to do with them.
771
772 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you see - you see two people...
773
774 KJELLBERG: Yep. Approaching. So, I don't - don't think he was hurt that bad if he was
775 coming back.
776
777 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.
778
779 KJELLBERG: Uh, you know?
780

781 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
782
783 KJELLBERG: I mean...
784
785 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
786
787 KJELLBERG: Um, I can tell you that's when I had talked with the operator inside. Um,
788 and she said, "They're on their way," and then I was gonna head upstairs,
789 you know, to see u-, you know, not even, what - two minutes later or
790 whatever, uh, and I'd seen the lights out front.
791
792 SGT. ZEBRO: Mm-hmm.
793
794 KJELLBERG: I actually - the - the tow truck driver called me and said, "Hey I'm here." I
795 peeked out the wi- the door and I said, "I - I really - I have to wait inside
796 right now." I just - I didn't want - I was that terrified. I just...
797
798 SGT. ZEBRO: Mm-hmm.
799
800 KJELLBERG: I didn't know what the other individuals were gonna do. Um, but the tow
801 truck driver was there. Um, I said, "As soon as the police are here, I'll
802 come out." Uh, I went around the building - seen the - the flashing lights. I
803 came out. Ran into the tow truck driver guy. Then went to the front of the
804 - my house and literally talked to - we'll just say Chad - I don't remember
805 his last name, um, the officer in charge or whatever and he took my keys,
806 took my phone, took my wallet, patted me down and put me in the back of
807 the car.
808
809 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Um, so you came out and talked to them - the cops when they were
810 out front?
811
812 KJELLBERG: Yep.
813
814 SGT. ZEBRO: ...and told 'em what happened?
815
816 KJELLBERG: Yep.
817
818 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
819
820 KJELLBERG: And there was a slew of 'em.
821
822 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. And did they...
823
824 KJELLBERG: Uh...
825
826 SGT. ZEBRO: ...tell you that - um, and you told them what - what happened?

827
828 KJELLBERG: Yep.
829
830 SGT. ZEBRO: Exactly what you just told me here?
831
832 KJELLBERG: Yep - yep.
833
834 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
835
836 KJELLBERG: Uh, told Chad. I - I don't know his last name. I'm sorry.
837
838 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
839
840 KJELLBERG: Um, the only reason I know his last - first name is 'cause I heard it
841 (unintelligible).
842
843 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. Yeah.
844
845 KJELLBERG: Um, and like I said I'm just trying to protect myself. Um, I go to the - I'm
846 a 100% disabled vet. I go to the VA on a weekly basis for medical
847 conditions that I have. Um, I'm just tryin' to protect my health - my- my
848 life.
849
850 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
851
852 KJELLBERG: Um, if people can't read - people can't understand to stay off my own
853 property - there's three signs there. I waited close to half an hour. Um, I
854 don't know what else to do.
855
856 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
857
858 KJELLBERG: I asked the police multiple times in the past to what can I do to prevent
859 people from parking on my t- my yard.
860
861 SGT. ZEBRO: So, when you say it's your yard is it your yard or is it a driveway or what
862 is it?
863
864 KJELLBERG: Right now it's tar but I'd like to turn into a yard. Um...
865
866 SGT. ZEBRO: So, it's actually a tar...
867
868 KJELLBERG: It's tar.
869
870 SGT. ZEBRO: Is it part of the alley or is it actually...
871
872 KJELLBERG: Well (unintelligible)

873
874 SGT. ZEBRO: ...right on your property?
875
876 KJELLBERG: Well a- a- I mean, it's p- it's alley - it's alley here and my asphalt is right
877 alongside of it.
878
879 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
880
881 KJELLBERG: Um, but like I said right where he parked there was - I could actually show
882 you this. I took a picture where he was parked and where the sign is that
883 says, "No Parking."
884
885 SGT. ZEBRO: Oh. Right.
886
887 KJELLBERG: Less than three feet from his door. Um...
888
889 SGT. ZEBRO: Is that on your phone?
890
891 KJELLBERG: Yes.
892
893 SGT. ZEBRO: Um...
894
895 KJELLBERG: Um, it's - like I said please - please talk to the other officers. It's, uh,
896 Drake - Drake Sands knows about issues I've had in the past along with
897 Justin Rangel. He also...
898
899 SGT. ZEBRO: Sure.
900
901 KJELLBERG: ...knows.
902
903 SGT. ZEBRO: Well so, like, you said there's some photos of where he parked? Was the
904 car still out there?
905
906 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
907
908 SGT. ZEBRO: So, he never came and moved it right?
909
910 KJELLBERG: No.
911
912 SGT. ZEBRO: But you have pictures of it too in your phone?
913
914 KJELLBERG: Yeah. That's how long I was sittin' out there...
915
916 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
917
918 KJELLBERG: ...waiting.

919
920 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, do you have - um, what - what I may do is...
921
922 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
923
924 SGT. ZEBRO: ...get a consent to search on your phone. Is that something you're willing
925 to do? Let us run through there...
926
927 KJELLBERG: No. I will show you if I have possession of my phone.
928
929 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
930
931 KJELLBERG: Um, because I've been waiting patiently to get a hold of my girlfriend to
932 tell her I'm okay.
933
934 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
935
936 KJELLBERG: 'Cause that's where I was supposed to be heading.
937
938 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
939
940 KJELLBERG: It's now over three hours later and she's probably terrified.
941
942 SGT. ZEBRO: Right. Okay.
943
944 KJELLBERG: So why terrify her for no reason?
945
946 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. We can call her too.
947
948 KJELLBERG: No. I would like to talk - call her.
949
950 SGT. ZEBRO: No. I mean, yeah but we'll...
951
952 KJELLBERG: So, it's - it's just I mean I've been more than cooperative. I just...
953
954 SGT. ZEBRO: No. I appreciate that you're being...
955
956 KJELLBERG: You know? Yeah.
957
958 SGT. ZEBRO: ...cooperative but the fact...
959
960 KJELLBERG: Yeah. No. I understand.
961
962 SGT. ZEBRO: Fact of the matter is...
963
964 KJELLBERG: No. I understand.

965
966 SGT. ZEBRO: ...someone got...
967
968 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
969
970 SGT. ZEBRO: ...assaulted and someone...
971
972 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
973
974 SGT. ZEBRO: ...got stabbed.
975
976 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
977
978 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you know?
979
980 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
981
982 SGT. ZEBRO: We got to...
983
984 KJELLBERG: No. I understand completely.
985
986 SGT. ZEBRO: We got to understand why.
987
988 KJELLBERG: I understand completely.
989
990 SGT. ZEBRO: So, I mean I'm gonna ask you obviously some questions about some spots
991 that that were maybe...
992
993 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
994
995 SGT. ZEBRO: ...I'm not clear.
996
997 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
998
999 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, but, uh, you know, and w-w- we'll try to figure it out from here so...
1000
1001 KJELLBERG: Yeah. No problem.
1002
1003 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, so I understand you had - you've been having problems with these
1004 guys parking there?
1005
1006 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1007
1008 SGT. ZEBRO: Which can be a huge problem for...
1009
1010 KJELLBERG: Yeah.

1011
1012 SGT. ZEBRO: ...a lot of people.
1013
1014 KJELLBERG: I've contacted the police. I've contacted the city.
1015
1016 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1017
1018 KJELLBERG: I was going to put a wall up there. Um, I had a plan. The city turned it
1019 down. I- it's - I've had issues for the last six years - seven years.
1020
1021 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1022
1023 KJELLBERG: Um, I don't know what else to do to prevent people from parking on my
1024 property.
1025
1026 SGT. ZEBRO: Right. Right.
1027
1028 KJELLBERG: Um, I can't call you guys every single time.
1029
1030 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1031
1032 KJELLBERG: I would love to but...
1033
1034 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1035
1036 KJELLBERG: ...it's not feasible because it's gonna take you probably a lot longer to
1037 show up than...
1038
1039 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1040
1041 KJELLBERG: They'll be gone.
1042
1043 SGT. ZEBRO: So, what - what was your goal when, um, when he shows up and - and...
1044
1045 KJELLBERG: I wanted him...
1046
1047 SGT. ZEBRO: ...wants to get his car?
1048
1049 KJELLBERG: I wanted him to stay off my property.
1050
1051 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1052
1053 KJELLBERG: I wanted the tow truck driver, who I already called, to come and tow the
1054 vehicle and the police to ticket it.
1055
1056 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.

1057
1058 KJELLBERG: Um...
1059
1060 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1061
1062 KJELLBERG: Because I have - he doesn't have the right to park on my property.
1063
1064 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1065
1066 KJELLBERG: I don't park on other people's and it's only - we'll say it's the only a- that
1067 only house currently...
1068
1069 SGT. ZEBRO: Yep.
1070
1071 KJELLBERG: Um, my neighbor I've - I gave him a letter saying I was - I was going to
1072 bring him to court if he keeps on bringing or having his friends park in my
1073 yard and...
1074
1075 SGT. ZEBRO: How many - how many cars can actually park on your property there - that
1076 can fit there?
1077
1078 KJELLBERG: Six?
1079
1080 SGT. ZEBRO: That much room huh?
1081
1082 KJELLBERG: Oh. Yeah. Plenty of room but that's why I have signs there too - three
1083 signs. I'm only required to have one. You know, please put that down.
1084
1085 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1086
1087 KJELLBERG: I'm only required to have one sign.
1088
1089 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.
1090
1091 KJELLBERG: I have three.
1092
1093 SGT. ZEBRO: Well, I have...
1094
1095 KJELLBERG: You know?
1096
1097 SGT. ZEBRO: I have three signs.
1098
1099 KJELLBERG: But I mean, it's - I don't want to - I - I ju- I could put a fence up right
1100 along the alley but then that pisses everybody off.
1101
1102 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.

1103
1104 KJELLBERG: Um, it is a known drug house. My neighbor's house is a known drug
1105 house. I- it's, um, they don't park in anybody else's yard or driveway.
1106
1107 SGT. ZEBRO: And I - I'm not hu- trust me I'm not judging you.
1108
1109 KJELLBERG: No.
1110
1111 SGT. ZEBRO: I'm just asking you...
1112
1113 KJELLBERG: No. I...
1114
1115 SGT. ZEBRO: ...questions.
1116
1117 KJELLBERG: ...understand.
1118
1119 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay?
1120
1121 KJELLBERG: No. I understand completely. I go- I get uptight because...
1122
1123 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1124
1125 KJELLBERG: ...uh, uh, this continuously happening.
1126
1127 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you want this - you want this car towed and ticketed?
1128
1129 KJELLBERG: Yes.
1130
1131 SGT. ZEBRO: Right? Um, but he comes on - on your property, right?
1132
1133 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1134
1135 SGT. ZEBRO: And he says he wants to get his car?
1136
1137 KJELLBERG: No. At first, I said, "Stay off my property."
1138
1139 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1140
1141 KJELLBERG: Um, multiple times and then he verbally assaulted me and then he
1142 physically assaulted me and said, "I want my vehicle."
1143
1144 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1145
1146 KJELLBERG: Um...
1147
1148 SGT. ZEBRO: I - I guess what...

1149
1150 KJELLBERG: And then...
1151
1152 SGT. ZEBRO: I'm kinda thinkin' what if he - what if he would have just got in his
1153 vehicle and left? Y- I know it wouldn't have solved - it would have solved
1154 it right there but it wouldn't have solved...
1155
1156 KJELLBERG: M...
1157
1158 SGT. ZEBRO: ...the issue with the parking forever.
1159
1160 KJELLBERG: What's sayin' he would have ca- come back tomorrow...
1161
1162 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1163
1164 KJELLBERG: ...and happen all over again?
1165
1166 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1167
1168 KJELLBERG: I'm not gonna argue with anybody over that but it's my...
1169
1170 SGT. ZEBRO: Um...
1171
1172 KJELLBERG: I'll come park at your house. How about that?
1173
1174 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah but, you know, you know what I mean?
1175
1176 KJELLBERG: Ye- u-, um, that - that's what I'm tryin' to say is - is...
1177
1178 SGT. ZEBRO: Wa- right but I'm asking...
1179
1180 KJELLBERG: You know?
1181
1182 SGT. ZEBRO: You know, like...
1183
1184 KJELLBERG: No.
1185
1186 SGT. ZEBRO: ...what?
1187
1188 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1189
1190 SGT. ZEBRO: I'm just tryin' to hear, like, a state of mind, like, what i- could you have
1191 just lettin' him...
1192
1193 KJELLBERG: I could have.
1194

1195 SGT. ZEBRO: ...like, drive away?
1196
1197 KJELLBERG: I probably could have but how many times?
1198
1199 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.
1200
1201 KJELLBERG: How many times do you keep on puttin' it off?
1202
1203 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1204
1205 KJELLBERG: (Unintelligible)
1206
1207 SGT. ZEBRO: So, I mean, fair enough. Uh, uh...
1208
1209 KJELLBERG: But he - he....
1210
1211 SGT. ZEBRO: But yeah. I know. Um...
1212
1213 KJELLBERG: No. Definitely. Um, and I, because, uh, I can only - I don't know - put it
1214 this way - I've asked what I could do. Nobody can - "Oh. We ca- we can't
1215 tell you what to do."
1216
1217 SGT. ZEBRO: They're basically - you're - what you're sayin' ...
1218
1219 KJELLBERG: I'm at - I'm at ends.
1220
1221 SGT. ZEBRO: Right. Could have - could have you did it but then he would have came
1222 back tomorrow and parked there again?
1223
1224 KJELLBERG: Who knows?
1225
1226 SGT. ZEBRO: So ultimately you wanted it ticketed...
1227
1228 KJELLBERG: Yes.
1229
1230 SGT. ZEBRO: ...and towed?
1231
1232 KJELLBERG: Yes. And if he's on my property he doesn't have the right to be on my
1233 property.
1234
1235 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1236
1237 KJELLBERG: Does he?
1238
1239 SGT. ZEBRO: No. Right. It, uh, it does get to be an issue when people are on your
1240 property.

1241
1242 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1243
1244 SGT. ZEBRO: Uh...
1245
1246 KJELLBERG: D- does he have the right to be on my property? That's...
1247
1248 SGT. ZEBRO: So...
1249
1250 KJELLBERG: ...that's the question I have.
1251
1252 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. I mean, you know, people could pass your property and everything
1253 like that but if there's no trespassing signs, you know, it - could you be
1254 ticketed for it? Yes. They can.
1255
1256 KJELLBERG: Please ticket 'em.
1257
1258 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.
1259
1260 KJELLBERG: And trespassing and assault but I'll - I'll get - I'll get ticketed for stabbing
1261 him.
1262
1263 SGT. ZEBRO: Well...
1264
1265 KJELLBERG: You know, it's - I don't know - I - I'm tired of - I'm getting tired of
1266 everything. Um, I try to buy a nice building that the city would put up for
1267 sale. I put tons of money into it to better the neighborhood and I get riff
1268 raff next to me.
1269
1270 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1271
1272 KJELLBERG: So, what am I to do? I keep on callin', you know, "We'll - we'll be right
1273 out." Well, they're already gone by the time they show up.
1274
1275 SGT. ZEBRO: Do you have cameras at your house?
1276
1277 KJELLBERG: Yes. And they're pointed at the doors.
1278
1279 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1280
1281 KJELLBERG: I don't need to know what happens in the yard.
1282
1283 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1284
1285 KJELLBERG: I need to know what's happenin' at, you know, at the...
1286

1287 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you have cameras at your own doors but nothing that, um...
1288
1289 KJELLBERG: No.
1290
1291 SGT. ZEBRO: Nothing in the yard?
1292
1293 KJELLBERG: Nope.
1294
1295 SGT. ZEBRO: Sounds like your neighbors got some, huh?
1296
1297 KJELLBERG: Yes. Josh?
1298
1299 SGT. ZEBRO: Uh, I don't know.
1300
1301 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Yeah. Those cameras look all over the place. What the hell is his
1302 last name?
1303
1304 SGT. ZEBRO: Well, he- here's - here's, like, the - what I'm tryin' to figure out here. I
1305 wanna see, um, you know, I completely understand that this guy is or
1306 these guys have been a problem to you.
1307
1308 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1309
1310 SGT. ZEBRO: You're tryin' to live a good life and be in your neighborhood.
1311
1312 KJELLBERG: Yeah. They don't think they...
1313
1314 SGT. ZEBRO: And to have people coming in your yard...
1315
1316 KJELLBERG: The thing is they don't even live there.
1317
1318 SGT. ZEBRO: Right. Right and - and trust me (unintelligible) which dealt with problem
1319 properties where we had this kind of stuff all the time. So, I - I get that.
1320 And I get that these guys are parkin' there and you wanna deal with it.
1321
1322 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
1323
1324 SGT. ZEBRO: Um...
1325
1326 KJELLBERG: I just - they were - there wo...
1327
1328 SGT. ZEBRO: I - I wanna make sure that you're doin' the right thing too because when
1329 you're talkin' about - uh, just - just hear me out.
1330
1331 KJELLBERG: No- uh-huh.
1332
1333

1333 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay? They had already looked at some of the cameras out there.
1334
1335 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1336
1337 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay? Um, and then talked to, I know, at least two people...
1338
1339 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1340
1341 SGT. ZEBRO: ...already, um, a- and this guy should not have come in your yard...
1342
1343 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1344
1345 SGT. ZEBRO: ...should not have parked there. Okay? But what I want you to be clear
1346 about is that just because you have a legitimate complaint.
1347
1348 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1349
1350 SGT. ZEBRO: Right? You have a very legitimate complaint.
1351
1352 KJELLBERG: And I should have dropped it.
1353
1354 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. No but I just want you to clear about is getting assaulted.
1355
1356 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1357
1358 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay? Because like I said they already u- there's a team out there right
1359 now that are pulling all the video...
1360
1361 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
1362
1363 SGT. ZEBRO: ...and they have already been watching it for...
1364
1365 KJELLBERG: I know.
1366
1367 SGT. ZEBRO: ...and that's why it took us a longer time.
1368
1369 KJELLBERG: No. That's fine.
1370
1371 SGT. ZEBRO: And then there was two people that they talked to as well.
1372
1373 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1374
1375 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay? He didn't have a right to come in your yard.
1376
1377 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
1378

1379 SGT. ZEBRO: He didn't have a right to not listen to you when he was in the yard.
1380
1381 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1382
1383 SGT. ZEBRO: But you gotta be careful with - about saying that he assaulted you and
1384 punching ya when that's not what they're seeing. Okay? And that's all I'm
1385 asking you to be is it's important to be straight about that.
1386
1387 KJELLBERG: Yep. I am.
1388
1389 SGT. ZEBRO: Hear me out because I want your - what happened with what you're
1390 saying can be legit but some of that doesn't - won't sound legit if you're
1391 not telling the truth the whole way because cameras don't lie. Right?
1392
1393 KJELLBERG: I'm not lying to you.
1394
1395 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1396
1397 KJELLBERG: If you keep on doing this, I will ask for my attorney.
1398
1399 SGT. ZEBRO: You - you ca...
1400
1401 KJELLBERG: I - I know but I'm ju...
1402
1403 SGT. ZEBRO: You can do whatever you want.
1404
1405 KJELLBERG: Yeah. I know.
1406
1407 SGT. ZEBRO: I'm just telling ya...
1408
1409 KJELLBERG: I know but don't accuse...
1410
1411 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay?
1412
1413 KJELLBERG: ...me of not...
1414
1415 SGT. ZEBRO: I'm telling you what they said and I'm trying to be straight with ya.
1416
1417 KJELLBERG: I am.
1418
1419 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay?
1420
1421 KJELLBERG: But if you're gonna accuse me of lying I'm not...
1422
1423 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Do you have marks, are there bruises?
1424

1425 KJELLBERG: Right here.
1426
1427 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1428
1429 KJELLBERG: And if you just - I mean, you can't tell 'cause I - I - I have facial hair so...
1430
1431 SGT. ZEBRO: All right.
1432
1433 KJELLBERG: But...
1434
1435 SGT. ZEBRO: So, what I wanna do is I'll get some pictures of...
1436
1437 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1438
1439 SGT. ZEBRO: Like, some of your bruising and stuff like that. Okay?
1440
1441 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1442
1443 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, but I just wanted to be clear on a couple points on that.
1444
1445 KJELLBERG: Uh-huh.
1446
1447 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay? What I'm...
1448
1449 KJELLBERG: And look at his hands.
1450
1451 SGT. ZEBRO: What I'll do - what's that?
1452
1453 KJELLBERG: Look at his hands.
1454
1455 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. I'll - yeah. Trust me.
1456
1457 KJELLBERG: You know?
1458
1459 SGT. ZEBRO: Give me a little bit. I'm gonna see if they can pull this up right now...
1460
1461 KJELLBERG: Yeah. No problem.
1462
1463 SGT. ZEBRO: ...get back here with it.
1464
1465 KJELLBERG: No problem.
1466
1467 SGT. ZEBRO: And then I'll come back to...
1468
1469 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1470

1471 SGT. ZEBRO: ...and we'll do it that way. Do you need anything here?
1472
1473 KJELLBERG: My phone.
1474
1475 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. I'll ask 'em where...
1476
1477 KJELLBERG: I mean...
1478
1479 SGT. ZEBRO: ...where - where the phone is.
1480
1481 KJELLBERG: Um, like I said it - I have an individual who cares very much about me
1482 who's probably worried sick. Um...
1483
1484 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1485
1486 KJELLBERG: You know? You keep on saying, "Oh. I'm very cooperative," and...
1487
1488 SGT. ZEBRO: You are but we still have to deal with...
1489
1490 KJELLBERG: I understand.
1491
1492 SGT. ZEBRO: ...you know, the crime and this other part, you know?
1493
1494 KJELLBERG: I understand that. I have no problem coming down here. I have no
1495 problem...
1496
1497 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.
1498
1499 KJELLBERG: ...talking to you.
1500
1501 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1502
1503 KJELLBERG: Do not accused me of lying though.
1504
1505 SGT. ZEBRO: I have to just tell ya what the - I - I...
1506
1507 KJELLBERG: (Unintelligable)
1508
1509 SGT. ZEBRO: And, I'm gonna, I'm gonna see... (unintelligible).
1510
1511 KJELLBERG: I understand that but du- please do not accuse me of that.
1512
1513 SGT. ZEBRO: Let me k- Brian a lot of times I'll - I'll - when we sit here...
1514
1515 KJELLBERG: I know.
1516

1517 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. And that - that is the case...
1518
1519 KJELLBERG: No. I...
1520
1521 SGT. ZEBRO: So, I have to go with what they're telling me...
1522
1523 KJELLBERG: No. I know.
1524
1525 SGT. ZEBRO: ...out there. So, there is - they're gonna recheck it.
1526
1527 KJELLBERG: (Unintelligible)
1528
1529 SGT. ZEBRO: And then i- wa- we can - if we could prove that...
1530
1531 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1532
1533 SGT. ZEBRO: ...differently that's what I'm gonna ask right now and make sure. Okay?
1534
1535 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1536
1537 SGT. ZEBRO: (Unintelligible).
1538
1539 KJELLBERG: That's the only thing I ask.
1540
1541 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Well technically...
1542
1543 KJELLBERG: You can tell me anything but just don't accuse me of not telling the truth.
1544
1545 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Um, yeah. Just give me...
1546
1547 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1548
1549 SGT. ZEBRO: I'll just be right back.
1550
1551 KJELLBERG: No problem. No problem.
1552
1553 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay? And I'm gonna find out where your phone is. You said one of the
1554 cops took it right away?
1555
1556 KJELLBERG: Uh, it was Chris - I can't remember his last name.
1557
1558 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1559
1560 KJELLBERG: The one in - who took the report itself.
1561
1562 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Thank you. They're pulling it out...

1563
1564 KJELLBERG: Alright.
1565
1566 SGT. ZEBRO: So, um, um, okay. Yeah. So, I think the neighbor that knows you says
1567 you're a good guy.
1568
1569 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1570
1571 SGT. ZEBRO: He knows you were in the military – things...
1572
1573 KJELLBERG: Uh-huh.
1574
1575 SGT. ZEBRO: ...like that so, um, (unintelligible)
1576
1577 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm. No problem.
1578
1579 SGT. ZEBRO: So, just a couple questions I...
1580
1581 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1582
1583 SGT. ZEBRO: ...just wanted me to ask you real quick so...
1584
1585 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
1586
1587 SGT. ZEBRO: ...and they did – they pulled – pulled it out. It looks – looks like you've
1588 had had plenty of - plenty of problems up there.
1589
1590 KJELLBERG: I know.
1591
1592 SGT. ZEBRO: You know?
1593
1594 KJELLBERG: That's why I've been trying to tell you. I'm sorry.
1595
1596 SGT. ZEBRO: (Unintelligible)
1597
1598 KJELLBERG: I just and I'm just...
1599
1600 SGT. ZEBRO: And there's probably a good chance that, you know, the cops come out
1601 there.
1602
1603 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1604
1605 SGT. ZEBRO: You know, they'll go - they'll ticket 'em...
1606
1607 KJELLBERG: If they're still there.
1608

1609 SGT. ZEBRO: And - right a- and the tow - the tow truck driver at that point - they
1610 probably won't have it towed but if the tow truck driver comes out you
1611 pay a fee for that...
1612
1613 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
1614
1615 SGT. ZEBRO: You know? Um, and the other thing I'm trying to figure out is, like, I
1616 completely get where you're coming from.
1617
1618 KJELLBERG: I know.
1619
1620 SGT. ZEBRO: You know?
1621
1622 KJELLBERG: Good.
1623
1624 SGT. ZEBRO: Like I said I wa- at the point that he's at your property - let me just - I
1625 know you wanna - you wanna deal with it but just - and you wanted him to
1626 get towed but you have to just let him go. You know what I mean?
1627
1628 KJELLBERG: I have in the past for the last six years.
1629
1630 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.
1631
1632 KJELLBERG: When do you - when do you...
1633
1634 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1635
1636 KJELLBERG: ...when do you wanna keep on getting trampled?
1637
1638 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you...
1639
1640 KJELLBERG: You wanna keep on getting walked on?
1641
1642 SGT. ZEBRO: No. Right.
1643
1644 KJELLBERG: I - that's a question for you.
1645
1646 SGT. ZEBRO: Do I want to? No. If they were parking...
1647
1648 KJELLBERG: Okay.
1649
1650 SGT. ZEBRO: ...on my address. No.
1651
1652 KJELLBERG: Okay.
1653
1654 SGT. ZEBRO: But I don't wanna get assaulted either.

1655
1656 KJELLBERG: No. And that's - but I did.
1657
1658 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. What do you mean what you...
1659
1660 KJELLBERG: That's what I did. I got assaulted.
1661
1662 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. That's what I mean.
1663
1664 KJELLBERG: Yeah. And...
1665
1666 SGT. ZEBRO: I don't want to get assaulted over here.
1667
1668 KJELLBERG: No and I didn't know he was gonna hit me.
1669
1670 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1671
1672 KJELLBERG: He tries to par- pushing me and I'm telling him, "Hey I got the cops on the
1673 phone." Whack, whack, whack to me. What am I gonna do?
1674
1675 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1676
1677 KJELLBERG: Um, if I wouldn't have dropped the phone, I wouldn't have gotten hit.
1678
1679 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1680
1681 KJELLBERG: Um, you know, it's - I don't know what else to tell ya. Um, there are no
1682 defensive wounds. I do not - I di- do not like to fight.
1683
1684 SGT. ZEBRO: Right. Well, I mean, all that makes sense.
1685
1686 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1687
1688 SGT. ZEBRO: You know?
1689
1690 KJELLBERG: It does.
1691
1692 SGT. ZEBRO: You know?
1693
1694 KJELLBERG: Um...
1695
1696 SGT. ZEBRO: Did you see anybody else out there with him at the time?
1697
1698 KJELLBERG: Nope. Except just, like, after he went back then two people came running
1699 or, you know...
1700

1701 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1702
1703 KJELLBERG: Um, and I could tell it was him because i- he had, like, braided hair.
1704
1705 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1706
1707 KJELLBERG: And you could just see it from the back with, um...
1708
1709 SGT. ZEBRO: Sorry.
1710
1711 KJELLBERG: No problem.
1712
1713 SGT. ZEBRO: This might be (unintelligible) - it sounds like your neighbor is helpful.
1714
1715 KJELLBERG: Good.
1716
1717 SGT. ZEBRO: So...
1718
1719 KJELLBERG: Dan or Josh?
1720
1721 SGT. ZEBRO: Josh.
1722
1723 KJELLBERG: Okay. Yeah. Dan's a nice guy.
1724
1725 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. So, you're - just what's the deal with this metal pipe? What is that
1726 all about?
1727
1728 KJELLBERG: It was just something I had in my pocket.
1729
1730 SGT. ZEBRO: What's it for though?
1731
1732 KJELLBERG: Tire deflater.
1733
1734 SGT. ZEBRO: So, it's a tire de...
1735
1736 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Yep.
1737
1738 SGT. ZEBRO: Oh. Do you deflate the tires if they're parked there?
1739
1740 KJELLBERG: No. No. I have not.
1741
1742 SGT. ZEBRO: What - when...
1743
1744 KJELLBERG: I don't even touch their vehicles.
1745
1746 SGT. ZEBRO: What's, uh, what's a tire deflator for? I mean, I'm just guessing?

1747
1748 KJELLBERG: To deflate tires but that doesn't mean I do it.
1749
1750 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1751
1752 KJELLBERG: Um, I just had it in my pocket.
1753
1754 SGT. ZEBRO: Did you bring it out there with you?
1755
1756 KJELLBERG: I just had it in my pocket.
1757
1758 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1759
1760 KJELLBERG: With no intention or, you know, I just probably had it to - had in my house
1761 - I was probably gonna put it in my car. I don't no- no idea. It was just - it
1762 was in my pocket.
1763
1764 SGT. ZEBRO: Oh. Okay.
1765
1766 KJELLBERG: I mean, I could have had a firearm, but I do not, you know, I did not have
1767 a firearm on me...
1768
1769 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1770
1771 KJELLBERG: ...even though I'm licensed to carry one.
1772
1773 SGT. ZEBRO: Are you?
1774
1775 KJELLBERG: Yes.
1776
1777 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1778
1779 KJELLBERG: But I, you know, did I? No. You know, that would have been a hell of a
1780 lot more problems, you know? Um...
1781
1782 SGT. ZEBRO: Did you bring it - I mean, did you bring it out there to protect yourself
1783 when he came back or...
1784
1785 KJELLBERG: No. Uh, nope. It was...
1786
1787 SGT. ZEBRO: Alright.
1788
1789 KJELLBERG: ...in - I - I didn't know w- where he was. It was in my pocket. Um...
1790
1791 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1792

1793 KJELLBERG: And I - I was gonna - I was gonna go to my truck and just take off but I
1794 was like, "No." I wanna tell the person, you know, if he probably would
1795 have been a bit more, um, personable, other than getting in my face, I
1796 probably would have had le - let him go.
1797

1798 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1799

1800 KJELLBERG: But when you start pushing and shoving what are you to do, like, other
1801 than defend yourself?
1802

1803 SGT. ZEBRO: Right. Right.
1804

1805 KJELLBERG: If he would have said, "Oh. Sorry. My...
1806

1807 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1808

1809 KJELLBERG: ...my mistake. I didn't see anything," you know, I probably would have
1810 said ye-, you know, like every other time I've done in the past, um, but it
1811 was not that. When you have an individual that gets up in your face, um,
1812 and starts hitting ya what - what are you gonna do? You gonna defend
1813 yourself or just take it?
1814

1815 SGT. ZEBRO: Well, that's a good question.
1816

1817 KJELLBERG: Well, it is. That's - I mean what is a normal person...
1818

1819 SGT. ZEBRO: Are ya - are ya asking me or...
1820

1821 KJELLBERG: No. Just a normal person.
1822

1823 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. I mean...
1824

1825 KJELLBERG: Do you just take it and let the, you know?
1826

1827 SGT. ZEBRO: No. No but, you know, like it- it's - it's a tough one because...
1828

1829 KJELLBERG: I - I get...
1830

1831 SGT. ZEBRO: You're getting - you're getting - you got punched.
1832

1833 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
1834

1835 SGT. ZEBRO: Right?
1836

1837 KJELLBERG: I've asked - I've asked for help many of times - many of times I've asked
1838 for help. Where is it?

1839
1840 SGT. ZEBRO: Uh, where's what?
1841
1842 KJELLBERG: Where's the help I keep on asking for?
1843
1844 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1845
1846 KJELLBERG: You know? Um, there was an officer. I can't remember his name. His
1847 name's in my phone. Gang Task Force guy or something undercover. You
1848 know, he said, "Yeah. We keep an eye on the place."
1849
1850 SGT. ZEBRO: Mm-hmm.
1851
1852 KJELLBERG: Well, I can't expect them to solely look at my place.
1853
1854 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1855
1856 KJELLBERG: There are places all over the place but that they know it's a troubled area –
1857 maybe a little bit more visible or something, you know? I don't know. I -
1858 it's not my job to d- determine that.
1859
1860 SGT. ZEBRO: I- it's just - it's a tough one because...
1861
1862 KJELLBERG: Yeah. No. I understand.
1863
1864 SGT. ZEBRO: You know, you got - you have him parking...
1865
1866 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1867
1868 SGT. ZEBRO: ...in your driveway...
1869
1870 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1871
1872 SGT. ZEBRO: ...which is b.s. and it's...
1873
1874 KJELLBERG: Yep.
1875
1876 SGT. ZEBRO: ...in a no-trespassing.
1877
1878 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Yep.
1879
1880 SGT. ZEBRO: He comes. He wants to get his car, right?
1881
1882 KJELLBERG: Yep, and if he probably would have - if he probably would have been...
1883
1884 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.

1885
1886 KJELLBERG: ...“Hey I’m sorry,”...
1887
1888 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.
1889
1890 KJELLBERG: ...fine. But when you get attacked.
1891
1892 SGT. ZEBRO: Right and then see and then he punches you?
1893
1894 KJELLBERG: Yeah. What am I...
1895
1896 SGT. ZEBRO: Obviously the next issue is obviously to a level of is that enough to stab
1897 someone, you know? You tell me...
1898
1899 KJELLBERG: It is better than shooting him.
1900
1901 SGT. ZEBRO: Right, but did you have a gun on you?
1902
1903 KJELLBERG: No.
1904
1905 SGT. ZEBRO: But it was enough to shoot him?
1906
1907 KJELLBERG: No.
1908
1909 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1910
1911 KJELLBERG: But I have no idea. I don’t know how long he’s gonna keep on attacking
1912 me.
1913
1914 SGT. ZEBRO: Right. Right.
1915
1916 KJELLBERG: W- you know, I’m not a mind reader.
1917
1918 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1919
1920 KJELLBERG: Right? So, do I just let him keep on attacking me ‘til I’m - who knows? I
1921 could be dead.
1922
1923 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1924
1925 KJELLBERG: Like I said I had a TBI two years ago - fractured eye socket right here...
1926
1927 SGT. ZEBRO: Mm-hmm.
1928
1929 KJELLBERG: ...that’s next to i- that’s where he hit me right here.
1930

1931 SGT. ZEBRO: Mm-hmm.
1932
1933 KJELLBERG: Um, I don't need to end up in the hospital again.
1934
1935 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
1936
1937 KJELLBERG: Um, I val- I value my life.
1938
1939 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. So, your goal when you stabbed him was what?
1940
1941 KJELLBERG: Protect myself.
1942
1943 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. From getting assaulted...
1944
1945 KJELLBERG: Yes.
1946
1947 SGT. ZEBRO: ...further?
1948
1949 KJELLBERG: Further.
1950
1951 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1952
1953 KJELLBERG: Um...
1954
1955 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
1956
1957 KJELLBERG: I have no idea what he was gonna do. He was pummeling me I guess p- u-,
1958 you know, protect myself, stay off my property and distance myself, um...
1959
1960 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.
1961
1962 KJELLBERG: I don't know what else to do. I - you know, like I said I can put up signs
1963 and I can ask people to leave but if it - they keep on happening.
1964
1965 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, I mean, honestly i- yeah, it's a tough situation.
1966
1967 KJELLBERG: Yep. Sure.
1968
1969 SGT. ZEBRO: Because we - we found out he had passed.
1970
1971 KJELLBERG: Okay.
1972
1973 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, so...
1974
1975 KJELLBERG: No. That's really tough.
1976

1977 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. And we're just trying to figure that out too, you know? You know, I
1978 - I feel for what you're going through too, you know?
1979
1980 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Thank you, sir.
1981
1982 SGT. ZEBRO: We gotta make sure we do everything right.
1983
1984 KJELLBERG: No, no it's...
1985
1986 SGT. ZEBRO: You know? Um, I just have to make sure that, you know, we check all the
1987 - all the boxes on this just because now, you know, in the situation that
1988 we're in here.
1989
1990 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
1991
1992 SGT. ZEBRO: You know, and, uh, and why did you call 911, you know, when this first
1993 happened? Um, and hopefully that - we have some of that on audio too,
1994 you know, from the 911 operator while this was going on, you know? And
1995 is there anything else that you can think of that you missed that, you know,
1996 I just wanna make sure that we have everything too. Sorry. I know there's
1997 a lot of stress for you too. Seriously Brian, I apologize. And I - can I
1998 explain u-u-, like, what I can see happening here or, like, as far as, like,
1999 the process is?
2000
2001 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2002
2003 SGT. ZEBRO: I'm gonn - before I do that, is there anything else you can think of that
2004 maybe I missed or that - what had happened?
2005
2006 KJELLBERG: No idea.
2007
2008 SGT. ZEBRO: What do you mean, you have no idea?
2009
2010 KJELLBERG: I - I, um, I'm just trying to recall it.
2011
2012 SGT. ZEBRO: Right. Right.
2013
2014 KJELLBERG: I don't...
2015
2016 SGT. ZEBRO: I know - I know you didn't want this to happen so, you know, I ha-, uh,
2017 I'm just trying to figure it out but...
2018
2019 KJELLBERG: I don't really think I can do anything right now.
2020
2021 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
2022

2023 KJELLBERG: Sorry. It's...
2024
2025 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
2026
2027 KJELLBERG: ...a little ov- overw- little - little, uh...
2028
2029 SGT. ZEBRO: So, from like, my experience in this, in the past, okay? Um, I w- I - I had
2030 to make sure that we understand everything that happened, okay?
2031
2032 KJELLBERG: Yep.
2033
2034 SGT. ZEBRO: And like I said they'll - they'll go through all of it - video - what they have
2035 out there. Um, and one thing that e- that we're gonna have to do though is
2036 - is we can't write the determination by ourselves whether what happens
2037 with you right now. Okay? Other than the fact that someone's dead, right?
2038
2039 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2040
2041 SGT. ZEBRO: And you gotta solve it, okay? But I have to do right by him just as much as
2042 I have do...
2043
2044 KJELLBERG: Oh. I...
2045
2046 SGT. ZEBRO: ...right by you.
2047
2048 KJELLBERG: I - I understand that.
2049
2050 SGT. ZEBRO: So, I'll take pictures. I'm gonna have 'em take some pictures and stuff like
2051 that. I'm assuming, you know, he punched you, you - you know.
2052
2053 KJELLBERG: Yes.
2054
2055 SGT. ZEBRO: And we'll get your clothing and stuff like...
2056
2057 KJELLBERG: Just...
2058
2059 SGT. ZEBRO: ...that.
2060
2061 KJELLBERG: ...pushed me.
2062
2063 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
2064
2065 KJELLBERG: But it's...
2066
2067 SGT. ZEBRO: That's what I mean.
2068

2069 KJELLBERG: And then, uh, like I said, uh, right here and then right here.
2070
2071 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
2072
2073 KJELLBERG: That's all.
2074
2075 SGT. ZEBRO: So, I'll grab some photos of that. We'll have to get your clothing. Okay?
2076 Um, and then what we'll do - end up doing is we'll work through the night
2077 on this, and we'll talk to a County Attorney in the morning. Okay? Um, at
2078 - at your house are there - it sounds like the thing was outside. You have a
2079 permit to carry too you said?
2080
2081 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2082
2083 SGT. ZEBRO: And - and you do have weapons in - in your house?
2084
2085 KJELLBERG: I do. Uh-huh.
2086
2087 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. That's fine.
2088
2089 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2090
2091 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, by weapons I mean firearms?
2092
2093 KJELLBERG: Uh-huh.
2094
2095 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. But you have a permit to carry so...
2096
2097 KJELLBERG: Yeah. And I could have easily went back in and got that but I chose not to.
2098
2099 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
2100
2101 KJELLBERG: I - like I said - yeah. If he'd just come right up and said, "Hey. I'm sorry.
2102 I'll move it." Fine.
2103
2104 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
2105
2106 KJELLBERG: Um, when they attack me, I have to defend myself.
2107
2108 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. But your - you said you have, um, it's a - you have guns in the
2109 house? Like, guns by the door or anything...
2110
2111 KJELLBERG: No.
2112
2113 SGT. ZEBRO: ...like that?
2114

2115 KJELLBERG: No. They're locked away.
2116
2117 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you have locked away...
2118
2119 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2120
2121 SGT. ZEBRO: ...guns?
2122
2123 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2124
2125 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Alright. I'll make sure I write that down too.
2126
2127 KJELLBERG: They're all locked up. They're u- they're registered.
2128
2129 SGT. ZEBRO: They're in a safe or what?
2130
2131 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2132
2133 SGT. ZEBRO: In the bedroom?
2134
2135 KJELLBERG: No. In the safe.
2136
2137 SGT. ZEBRO: What's that?
2138
2139 KJELLBERG: In a safe.
2140
2141 SGT. ZEBRO: So - yeah - what I'm gonna do is I'm gonna have - I'm gonna come in
2142 here and get some photos. Okay? Um, we're gonna talk to some more
2143 witnesses and everything like that. The process we usually - will be that
2144 you're gonna go on over to the jail...
2145
2146 KJELLBERG: Mm.
2147
2148 SGT. ZEBRO: ...tonight. Okay? And at least stay in there until we can talk to the
2149 attorney. Okay? They make the determination. Um, I don't foresee this
2150 going a long time because everything is pretty self-explanatory and - and
2151 as long as we're working through the night we should be able to brief the
2152 attorney tomorrow. Okay? And - and they decide whether there's charges
2153 warranted for you or not. Okay?
2154
2155 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
2156
2157 SGT. ZEBRO: Uh, you know, we - we have people out there and we have - and we're
2158 gonna try and do the best we can with everything - with video - with
2159 witnesses. We talk to anybody we can. Okay? Do have questions for me at
2160 all?

2161
2162 KJELLBERG: Just the same one.
2163
2164 SGT. ZEBRO: What's that?
2165
2166 KJELLBERG: Can I make a phone call?
2167
2168 SGT. ZEBRO: You wanna call your...
2169
2170 KJELLBERG: Girlfriend.
2171
2172 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah - yeah. Absolutely. Absolutely. Do you have her number if...
2173
2174 KJELLBERG: No, I don't.
2175
2176 SGT. ZEBRO: ...they have your phone? You don't have her number?
2177
2178 KJELLBERG: I don't have it memorized.
2179
2180 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. And she doesn't live at your house?
2181
2182 KJELLBERG: No.
2183
2184 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
2185
2186 KJELLBERG: It's just me.
2187
2188 SGT. ZEBRO: Give me a little bit to talk - I'm gonna have - be able to have you do that. I
2189 completely understand and you're gonna be able to call her. Okay? Um,
2190 the only thing is what I worry about is I'm gonna - or well not what I'm
2191 worried about is, your phone just because you got pictures of that we're
2192 gonna hold onto that until the attorney decides what they're gonna do.
2193 Okay?
2194
2195 KJELLBERG: That's fine.
2196
2197 SGT. ZEBRO: I'm still gonna let you get the number and, uh, and call.
2198
2199 KJELLBERG: Like I said, I just took a picture of the license plate and I took a picture of
2200 his vehicle right next to the, "No Parking," sign.
2201
2202 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
2203
2204 KJELLBERG: Um, and like I said there's probably plenty of photos right now, um, of the
2205 other two signs as well.
2206

2207 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Alright. I hate to walk out of here for a little bit but it – ‘cause I
2208 don’t like to leave people like this but it - it - is there something you need
2209 at all besides - besides getting you that...
2210
2211 KJELLBERG: Mm-mm.
2212
2213 SGT. ZEBRO: ...uh, the call?
2214
2215 KJELLBERG: I’m fine.
2216
2217 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. I appreciate that you’re straight and just kinda told us what, you
2218 know, what happened out there.
2219
2220 KJELLBERG: It’s all I can do.
2221
2222 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah.
2223
2224 KJELLBERG: I don’t know what else to do.
2225
2226 SGT. ZEBRO: I know.
2227
2228 KJELLBERG: I mean, it’s - it’s - ask the police, look at the reports. Look at the - talk to
2229 Rangel talk to Drake Sands...
2230
2231 SGT. ZEBRO: Mm-hmm.
2232
2233 KJELLBERG: ...um, they know I’ve had issues in the past.
2234
2235 SGT. ZEBRO: Sure.
2236
2237 KJELLBERG: Um, I don’t remember the other officer’s name - the, uh, he’s the
2238 undercover, um...
2239
2240 SGT. ZEBRO: No. That’s fine. You know, and we can look...
2241
2242 KJELLBERG: Yes.
2243
2244 SGT. ZEBRO: We can pull up plenty of stuff on it.
2245
2246 KJELLBERG: Yeah. And it’s just...
2247
2248 SGT. ZEBRO: Right. Okay. No. I appreciate it. Just give me a little bit and I’m gonna
2249 come back in here. I’ll get those photos done and then I’m gonna have the
2250 officers take your clothing, you know? We’ll get all that off your clothing.
2251 Um, they’re gonna - they’re gonna put, like, some kinda jail...
2252

2253 KJELLBERG: Yeah. I know.
2254
2255 SGT. ZEBRO: ...like, on - on you.
2256
2257 KJELLBERG: I understand.
2258
2259 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
2260
2261 KJELLBERG: That's fine. It's - it's - it's required - it's...
2262
2263 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
2264
2265 KJELLBERG: ...protocol. I understand all that, sir.
2266
2267 SGT. ZEBRO: So, give me a minute. Let me grab the camera. I'm gonna take those quick
2268 and get those out of the way too while they're getting the - like I said
2269 we're gonna have to get that number off your phone before I - I'll bring it
2270 in here though.
2271
2272 KJELLBERG: Thank you.
2273
2274 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay? Yeah.
2275
2276 SGT. ZEBRO: Alright. Hey Brian.
2277
2278 KJELLBERG: Hi.
2279
2280 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, let me do this first before we start. I wanna get, like, some full photos
2281 of you. And I'm gonna try and get some of your injuries. Did you say you
2282 fell into that rock pile?
2283
2284 KJELLBERG: I fell backwards.
2285
2286 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. And you got somethin' on your back too you think?
2287
2288 KJELLBERG: I just - I don't know.
2289
2290 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Well...
2291
2292 KJELLBERG: But yeah.
2293
2294 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah? We're gonna try to get...
2295
2296 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
2297
2298 SGT. ZEBRO: ...some closeups of your face here. Okay? (Unintelligible) ...those

2299 injuries.
2300
2301 KJELLBERG: Well, it's just my, you know, left cheekbone here and my right jaw. Do
2302 you want me to point right to where I feel it?
2303
2304 SGT. ZEBRO: Please do.
2305
2306 KJELLBERG: Alright. Right there.
2307
2308 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
2309
2310 KJELLBERG: And then right...
2311
2312 SGT. ZEBRO: Wait just...
2313
2314 KJELLBERG: I'm sorry.
2315
2316 SGT. ZEBRO: That's okay. Alright. Can you point to the spot for me?
2317
2318 KJELLBERG: Right here. Sorry. I have light - very bad light sensitivity.
2319
2320 SGT. ZEBRO: No. no. That's fine. Can I see your hands too please?
2321
2322 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Mm-hmm.
2323
2324 SGT. ZEBRO: Wait tilt it back forward. Now you can tilt them. Alright. And do you
2325 think - so do me a favor.
2326
2327 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2328
2329 SGT. ZEBRO: Can you just take your coat off for me here?
2330
2331 KJELLBERG: Yeah. No problem.
2332
2333 SGT. ZEBRO: And then just turn around here. We're gonna try to get just everything
2334 done now. Alright. Can you lift your shirt up and maybe we'll have some
2335 marks there? Okay. Where did you fall? Where did it hit when...
2336
2337 KJELLBERG: Just right on my butt.
2338
2339 SGT. ZEBRO: Did your back hit at all?
2340
2341 KJELLBERG: No.
2342
2343 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Okay. Um, you can put your coat back on for now. So, I'm gonna...
2344

2345 KJELLBERG: I'll just leave it off if you're gonna take it.
2346
2347 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. Well, it should be easier with it off for now. Um, obviously, you
2348 know, he touched you - you touched him so we're gonna have to - we're
2349 gonna do DNA. Would you be willin' to...
2350
2351 KJELLBERG: Uh, yeah.
2352
2353 SGT. ZEBRO: ...give consent to DNA...
2354
2355 KJELLBERG: Sure.
2356
2357 SGT. ZEBRO: ...and collect your DNA?
2358
2359 KJELLBERG: They already...state already - the Feds already have it.
2360
2361 SGT. ZEBRO: Right. Okay. Oh, for...for...
2362
2363 KJELLBERG: Government.
2364
2365 SGT. ZEBRO: Government. Okay. So, yeah, we'll just have to get new samples.
2366
2367 SGT. ZEBRO: So, I'll bring you a consent form on that, um, and then we'll setup the
2368 phone call. Okay? But you're gonna have to do it on speaker just so, you
2369 know...
2370
2371 KJELLBERG: That's fine.
2372
2373 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay?
2374
2375 KJELLBERG: That's fine.
2376
2377 SGT. ZEBRO: Alright. Alright. So, I'll grab that...
2378
2379 KJELLBERG: Can I just...
2380
2381 SGT. ZEBRO: ...the DNA form.
2382
2383 KJELLBERG: I'm just trying to make people so they don't have to worry about me.
2384
2385 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. No. I get it.
2386
2387 SGT. ZEBRO: I - I get it.
2388
2389 SGT. ZEBRO: (Unintelligible)
2390

2391 KJELLBERG: Oh.
2392
2393 SGT. ZEBRO: This the back of your place?
2394
2395 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Want me to draw right where he was parked?
2396
2397 SGT. ZEBRO: Can you just draw on that, like, X, you know, where you think he was
2398 parked?
2399
2400 KJELLBERG: Well, I know right where he's parked. Well, he was, like, right behind the
2401 pole here but really right there. The sign is right here, right here and right
2402 here. There are three signs.
2403
2404 SGT. ZEBRO: So, if you look here your property goes past this...
2405
2406 KJELLBERG: My property all - goes all the way to the other side over here - all over
2407 here...
2408
2409 SGT. ZEBRO: Can you draw a line, like, down? Are you sayin' it's right...
2410
2411 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Yeah.
2412
2413 SGT. ZEBRO: Does your property go right here?
2414
2415 KJELLBERG: No. No. No. The pole is the property line and, right where the pole to pole
2416 - that's my property line right there.
2417
2418 SGT. ZEBRO: Alright.
2419
2420 KJELLBERG: Yeah. It's - there's a store over here. They can easily park in their parking
2421 lot. There's a driveway here. There's a driveway - Dan's driveway.
2422
2423 SGT. ZEBRO: Right.
2424
2425 KJELLBERG: It's right here. Um...
2426
2427 SGT. ZEBRO: So, I just - I - I - showed you this.
2428
2429 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2430
2431 SGT. ZEBRO: Can you just initial here and then...
2432
2433 KJELLBERG: No - no problem.
2434
2435 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, okay. So now that's - that's just a Voluntary DNA Consent Form.
2436 This is just asking about getting your DNA and that's just two swabs in

2437 your mouth. We collect that and, uh, and seal them all up.
2438
2439 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
2440
2441 SGT. ZEBRO: Um...
2442
2443 KJELLBERG: Can you test for Covid too? Sorry. I'm just...
2444
2445 SGT. ZEBRO: Don't tell me you have that. Do you?
2446
2447 KJELLBERG: No. No. I'm ju- I've had all my shots. Even had my booster shot.
2448
2449 SGT. ZEBRO: So, you wanna read that and then if you print your name up here - sign it
2450 right here. Okay?
2451
2452 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
2453
2454 SGT. ZEBRO: There you go. Alright.
2455
2456 KJELLBERG: I would like to make that phone call.
2457
2458 SGT. ZEBRO: Yep. You mean, to your - to your girlfriend?
2459
2460 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2461
2462 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. You for sure can make a phone call. Absolutely.
2463
2464 KJELLBERG: Okay.
2465
2466 SGT. ZEBRO: I have no problem with that. Let me get your signature though.
2467
2468 KJELLBERG: When - when - when will I get the - when d- when can I get that?
2469
2470 SGT. ZEBRO: You're gonna do the phone call right after that. I'm gonna bring your
2471 phone...
2472
2473 KJELLBERG: Oh okay.
2474
2475 SGT. ZEBRO: ...in here.
2476
2477 KJELLBERG: I'm sorry. I just - I...
2478
2479 SGT. ZEBRO: No. That's okay. I get it.
2480
2481 KJELLBERG: I just...
2482

2483 SGT. ZEBRO: Hey the only thing I have on this job is my word.
2484
2485 KJELLBERG: M- I know.
2486
2487 SGT. ZEBRO: So, I'm gonna make - yeah - if I say I'm gonna somethin' it's, you know,
2488 I'm gonna do it.
2489
2490 KJELLBERG: It's just...
2491
2492 SGT. ZEBRO: I get it. Y- you're stressed out too. I'm - you have a right to be...
2493
2494 KJELLBERG: I - I didn't expect...
2495
2496 SGT. ZEBRO: I know. Actually, I'm gonna bring that phone in here now and I'll get out
2497 of here (unintelligible).
2498
2499 KJELLBERG: Thank you.
2500
2501 SGT. ZEBRO: Hey can you just grab that cellphone and - or can I have that?
2502
2503 KJELLBERG: And we can also turn it off so it just stops ringin'.
2504
2505 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. We'll put it on, uh...
2506
2507 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
2508
2509 SGT. ZEBRO: In here. Thank you.
2510
2511 MAN: Yep.
2512
2513 SGT. ZEBRO: (Unintelligible). Just turn it on for me.
2514
2515 KJELLBERG: No problem.
2516
2517 SGT. ZEBRO: Is that your phone?
2518
2519 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2520
2521 SGT. ZEBRO: Like I said when we get done here too, the phone call you gotta make it
2522 on...
2523
2524 KJELLBERG: Oh. That's fine. I have no problem doing it on speaker. I just want to let
2525 somebody know I'm okay.
2526
2527 SGT. ZEBRO: Yep. Ca- can you just open your mouth for me? I'm gonna swab both
2528 sides for you. Okay?

2529
2530 KJELLBERG: Yeah. Thank you. They sure put a lot of stuff in there.
2531
2532 SGT. ZEBRO: What's that?
2533
2534 KJELLBERG: They put a lot of stuff in there.
2535
2536 SGT. ZEBRO: I know. We'll leave this up 'cause I don't wanna forget that. Here.
2537
2538 KJELLBERG: I'm surprised it's still got a signal. It's very occasional - very
2539 (unintelligible).
2540
2541 SGT. ZEBRO: What's your girlfriend's name?
2542
2543 KJELLBERG: Uh, Jennifer.
2544
2545 SGT. ZEBRO: What's her last name?
2546
2547 KJELLBERG: M- Robinson.
2548
2549 SGT. ZEBRO: Robinson?
2550
2551 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
2552
2553 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Here we go now. Have you got a passcode to get into that?
2554
2555 KJELLBERG: My fingerprint.
2556
2557 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. You don't know the number?
2558
2559 KJELLBERG: Nope.
2560
2561 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Can you just do me a favor? I'm gonna hold this right here.
2562
2563 KJELLBERG: Yeah. No problem.
2564
2565 SGT. ZEBRO: Do your fingerprint and then...
2566
2567 KJELLBERG: Ten phone calls - recent - top one.
2568
2569 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay..
2570
2571 KJELLBERG: Alright?
2572
2573 SGT. ZEBRO: And I'll just hang on to it. Okay?
2574

2575 KJELLBERG: Speaker. That's the...
2576
2577 SGT. ZEBRO: Take your time.
2578
2579 KJELLBERG: Thank you.
2580
2581 SGT. ZEBRO: No. Well, thank you.
2582
2583 JENNIFER: Hello?
2584
2585 KJELLBERG: Jen?
2586
2587 JENNIFER: Hi.
2588
2589 KJELLBERG: Hi. I just wanted to let you know I'm okay and I'll talk to you tomorrow.
2590 Okay?
2591
2592 JENNIFER: Oh. What happened?
2593
2594 KJELLBERG: I - I need...
2595
2596 JENNIFER: Where are you? Well, I'm not...
2597
2598 KJELLBERG: I just - I - I'll talk to you tomorrow if that's okay.
2599
2600 JENNIFER: Are you okay?
2601
2602 KJELLBERG: Not really but I'll - I'll talk to you tomorrow.
2603
2604 JENNIFER: You don't - well what's goin' on - can I help?
2605
2606 KJELLBERG: Not right now.
2607
2608 JENNIFER: Alright.
2609
2610 KJELLBERG: Alright. I'll talk to you later.
2611
2612 JENNIFER: Okay.
2613
2614 KJELLBERG: Alright.
2615
2616 JENNIFER: Bye.
2617
2618 KJELLBERG: See you later. Okay.
2619
2620 SGT. ZEBRO: Do you - let me wri- have you write this down, hang on, hang on, hang on-

2667 KJELLBERG: No. I just...
2668
2669 SGT. ZEBRO: I got it. I'm gonna put it in this bag too. I'll tell you about that too. So,
2670 they're gonna come in and collect your clothing.
2671
2672 KJELLBERG: Good.
2673
2674 SGT. ZEBRO: Um, y- and they - 'cause the DNA could have been, you know...
2675
2676 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2677
2678 SGT. ZEBRO: (Unintelligible) Um, yeah and then...
2679
2680 KJELLBERG: And sh- and he should have DNA on his hands too, right?
2681
2682 SGT. ZEBRO: Yeah. Well, trust me. They - the doctors (Unintelligible) Um, they're
2683 gonna collect it. They're gonna put that on ya, kind of explained the
2684 process to you. Okay?
2685
2686 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
2687
2688 SGT. ZEBRO: And then it's - it - well hear me out (unintelligible)
2689
2690 KJELLBERG: I got some time.
2691
2692 SGT. ZEBRO: I'm use - I try doin' right, like...
2693
2694 KJELLBERG: No. No. That's fine.
2695
2696 SGT. ZEBRO: You know, you're not leaving here any way so, you know,so they'll do
2697 their job and make the determination of, like, what's goin' on. Okay?
2698
2699 KJELLBERG: Mm-hmm.
2700
2701 SGT. ZEBRO: And, uh, we may be back to come and talk to ya and get it all in order but
2702 I appreciate you bein' cooperative and...
2703
2704 KJELLBERG: Tryin' to be.
2705
2706 SGT. ZEBRO: I'm no- I'm not holdin' phone calls from ya or anything like that like a jail
2707 or somethin'.
2708
2709 KJELLBERG: No. It just, like I said, I just had to let one person know.
2710
2711 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay.
2712

2713 KJELLBERG: I mean, I've been trying since we started.
2714
2715 MAN: We're gonna go...
2716
2717 SGT. ZEBRO: Uh, maybe - maybe, uh, at 12:47.
2718
2719 MAN: ...all the way down.
2720
2721 KJELLBERG: That's su...
2722
2723 SGT. ZEBRO: 'Cause your...
2724
2725 KJELLBERG: ...five hours I've been tryin' to call her.
2726
2727 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. I know.
2728
2729 KJELLBERG: Okay. Alright.
2730
2731 SGT. ZEBRO: Hey, Brian. We'll - we'll figure this out. Okay? Alright. We're gonna take
2732 care of that right now. I told them to - stay here. I'm gonna run this up.
2733
2734 KJELLBERG: I don't have any.
2735
2736 SGT. ZEBRO: Okay. Um, yeah.
2737
2738 KJELLBERG: Yeah.
2739
