TEAMSTERS LOCAL 320 AND UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA REACH TENTATIVE AGREEMENT ENDING LABOR STRIKE FOR 1,400 TEAMSTERS

The University of Minnesota Offered a Strike Settlement and Teamsters Negotiating Committee has Tentatively Agreed to the Offer. Now Members Must Vote to Ratify Final Agreement

Minneapolis, Minn.-

On Friday at midnight, the Local 320 negotiating committee approved a tentative agreement (TA) to be sent to all University Teamsters for ratification.

The TA officially ended the strike and picketing has ceased on all university campuses.

The agreement is for three years and provides a 3.5% increase in year 1, another 3.5% increase in year 2, with a 3% increase in the third and final year.

Most important of all, the agreement maintains its June 30 expiration date.

"This was a hard-fought strike that we won on the picket lines and with solidarity from Teamster delivery drivers and other unions such as IATSE Local 13," says Erik Skoog, Local 320 president. "We also must recognize the solidarity from the Farm Aid performers and event coordinators who refused to cross a Teamster picket line."

Logistics for the system-wide vote are still being developed with union stewards on all university campuses. It will take a simple majority voting to affirm the TA to complete the ratification process.

"We would not have been successful without the support of our 1,400 members," says Skoog. "I am so proud of their diligence and resolve in maintaining a concerted strike at multiple locations across the State of Minnesota."
